- All quilts to be submitted to Northcott. The top 15 finalists' quilts will be displayed at Quilt Canada in Toronto, Ontario from June 14th to 17th, 2017. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 quilts based on Viewers' Choice.

- **First place prize:**
BERNINA 570 QE Sewing Machine (\$4,799 value) and Northcott Premium Fabric (\$200 value).
- **Second place prize:**
selection of Northcott Premium Fabric (\$125 value).
- **Third place prize:**
selection of Northcott Premium Fabric (\$75 value).
