

1/2 yard of batting

Seam allowances:


Use ¼" seam allowance

Instructions:
1. Cut out all the pre-printed book pages/cover along the outer edges.

- 2. Cut out a piece of batting 1/2" larger than the cover. Note the cover and pages 10|1 are slightly larger than the other pages.

 3. Place the book cover on too of the batting (wrong side of cover ON the batting). Place page 1011 on too of the book cover, right sides together. Pin.
- 4. Stitch around the perimeter of the pages leaving an opening in the bottom for turning.
- 5. Carefully trim the excess batting away and trim the corners.6. Turn right sides out and press.
- 7. Turn the seam allowance under and close the opening with a slip stitch or a narrow piece of fusible web.
- Repeat Step 2 7 with pages 9|2 and 3|8 for one combination and pages 7|4 and 5|6 for the second combination
 Place the cover face down on your work surface. Page 1|10 will be facing up.
- 10. Place the remaining two page sections on top of the first piece in the correct sequence, centering these pages on the cover which is slightly larger
- 11. Draw a stitching line down the center of the top page. Pin or baste the three sections together and stitch. Make sure you anchor the seam at the beginning and end of the row of stitching.
