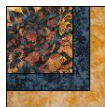

Block 1 Assembly:

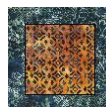
- With right sides together, sew a Fabric C 1 ½" x 6 ½" strip to one side of a Fabric A, Motif 1 6 ½" square.
Add a Fabric C 1 ½" x 7 ½" strip to one perpendicular side.



- With right sides together, add a Fabric D 1 ½" x 7 ½" strip, then a Fabric D 1 ½" x 8 ½" strip to the same two sides as in Step 1. This completes Block 1. Repeat to make 14 Block 1's.

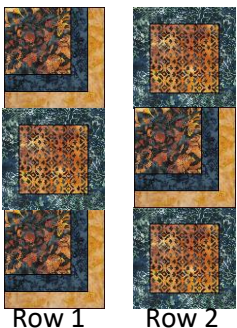


- With right sides together, sew a Fabric B 1 ½" x 6 ½" strip to opposite sides of a Fabric A, Motif 2 6 ½" square.
Then add Fabric B 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips to the remaining two sides.
This completes Block 2. Repeat to make 13 Block 2's.



Quilt Top Assembly:

1. Sew blocks together to make 9 vertical rows of 3 blocks each, alternating Block 1 & block 2 as shown. Press seams in one direction for Row 1, and in the opposite direction for Row 2. This will make seams nest when sewing the rows together.



Continue alternating Row 1 & Row 2, ending with a Row 1.

2. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt top.
3. Sew the Fabric E $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips together. Cut two inner border strips for the long sides (approximately $72\frac{1}{2}$ " at this point). With right sides together, sew these strips to the long edges of the quilt top. Cut two inner border strips for the short sides (approximately $26\frac{1}{2}$ " at this point). Add to quilt top in the same manner.
4. Sew the Fabric F $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips together. Cut two outer border strips for the long sides (approximately $74\frac{1}{2}$ " at this point). With right sides together, sew these strips to the long edges of the quilt top. Cut two outer border strips for the short sides (approximately $30\frac{1}{2}$ " at this point). Add to quilt top in the same manner.
5. Prepare binding from the Fabric E $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Layer quilt top with batting & backing. Quilt and bind as desired.
