
# Catching Some Zzz's

## Catching Some Zzz's

Finished Size  $-66" \times 85"$ Block Size  $-18" \times 18"$ WOF = width of fabric All seams are sewn using a % seam allowance


#### **Requirements:**

Gold, Greens & Blues	Red, Orange & Brown	Yardage	Cutting Instructions
FQDEST16-42	FQDEST16-25	1 bundle (16 FQ's)	See instructions & diagram below.
Fabric A	Fabric A	1 1/2 yds	Cut 5 – 3 7/8" x WOF strips
81600-11	81600-11		<ul> <li>➤ Sub-cut 48 – 3 7/8" squares (for HSTs)</li> <li>Cut 15 – 2" x WOF strips (for Sashing &amp; Inner Border)</li> <li>➤ Sub-cut 8 - 2" x 18 ½" strips</li> <li>➤ Join the remaining strips together end to end; from this long strip, cut 5 – 2" x 57 ½" and 2 – 2" x 80" strips</li> </ul>
Fabric B 80830-64	Fabric B 80835-35	7/8 yd	Cut 8 – 3 ½" x WOF strips (for Outer Border)
Fabric C 80834-64	Fabric C 80832-36	5/8 yd	Cut 8 – 2 ½" x WOF strips (set aside for Binding)
Lengthwise Backing: 80836-69	Lengthwise Backing: 80832-37	5 ½ yds	Cut in half along the length of the fabric to get 2 – 2 ¾ yd x WOF pieces. Join the two pieces along the selvage edges.

#### **Block Assembly:**


NOTE: Each Fat Quarter will yield 3 – 9 ½" x 9 ½" 'Z' Units.

- 1. From each FQ, cut 3-3 %" x 21" strips, 3-3 7/8" squares, and 3-3 %" squares as shown in the FQ Cutting Diagram.
- 2. From each  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" strip, sub-cut  $2 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.
- 3. Pair each 3 7/8" square with a Fabric A 3 7/8" square with right sides together and pin in place. Mark a diagonal line on the Fabric A squares from corner to corner. Sew a ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line. Then cut apart on the line.

4. Open and press to the dark side to yield two HST's from each pair.



5. To assemble each 'Z' Unit, lay out  $2-3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, 2 HST's and  $1-3 \frac{1}{2}$ " square as shown. Sew blocks together in middle row. Then sew rows together to complete the 'Z' Unit.



- 6. Make three 'Z' Units from each FQ to yield a total of 48 'Z' Units.
- 7. Arrange 'Z' Units in groups of four. Lay out each group, turning two of the units as shown.



8. Sew units together to complete one 'Z' Block. Repeat to make 12 'Z' Blocks.





#### **Quilt Top Assembly:**

- 1. Arrange 'Z' Blocks into four rows of three, placing a 2" x 18 ½" sashing strip between each block.
- 2. Sew together to complete each row.
- 3. Sew rows together, adding a  $2'' \times 57 \%''$  sashing strip between each row, and to the top & bottom of the quilt top.
- 4. Sew a 2" x 80" sashing strip to each side of the quilt top to complete the inner border.
- 5. Join the 3 ½" x WOF Outer Border strips end to end. From this long strip, cut 2-3½" x 80" border strips and sew to each side of the quilt top. Then cut 2-3½" x 66 ½" border strips and sew to the top & bottom of the quilt top.
- 6. To prepare binding, join the binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Fold in half wrong sides together along the length of the strip and press.
- 7. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
