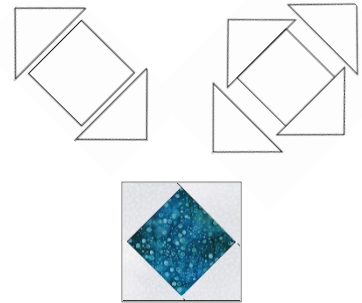


Requirements & Cutting Instructions:

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting Instructions
Fabric A CPOPDOTS32-10 	1 Chip Pack (32 – 5" squares)	No cutting required for blocks. Choose 4 chips for sashing corners and cut each in half twice. 
Fabric B 81900-27 (Binding) 	3/8 yd	Cut 5 – 2 1/2" x WOF strips
Fabric C 81205-10 (Background) 	2 yds	Cut 7 – 5" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 50 – 5" squares and cut each square once on the diagonal  Cut 12 – 2 1/2" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 40 – 2 1/2" x 7 1/4" sashing strips, 2 – 42 1/4" side border strips and 2 – 46 1/4" top & bottom border strips (Join strips end to end as needed and trim to size for the border strips.)
81900-29 (Backing) 	1 1/2 yds	No cutting required.

Square-In-A-Square Block Assembly:

1. Lay out 25 Fabric A 5" chips and four Fabric C triangles for each chip. Center and sew the long edge of one triangle to one edge of the square. Repeat on the opposite edge of the square. Press seams toward the triangles. Center and sew the remaining triangles on the remaining edges of the square in the same manner to complete the block. **TIP:** Fold each piece in half and finger press to find the centers to line up the triangles on the square. Repeat to make 50 blocks. Trim blocks to 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

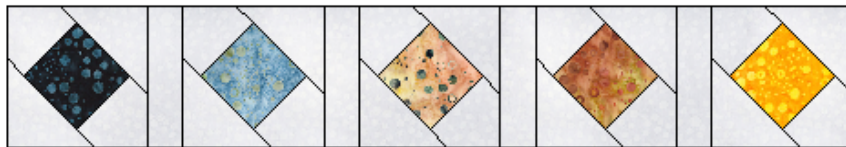


Sashing & Quilt Top Assembly:

1. To make horizontal sashing rows, sew five 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric C sashing strips together, adding a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square between each strip. Repeat to make four sashing rows.



2. Referring to the finished quilt image, or to your liking, arrange the blocks into five rows of five blocks each.
3. Sew blocks together, adding a Fabric C sashing strip between each block to complete rows.



4. Sew rows together, adding a sashing row between each row of blocks.
5. Add a side border strip to each side of the quilt top. Then add top & bottom borders to complete the quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt:

1. Join Fabric B binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Fold in half, wrong sides together, along the length of the strip and press.
2. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
