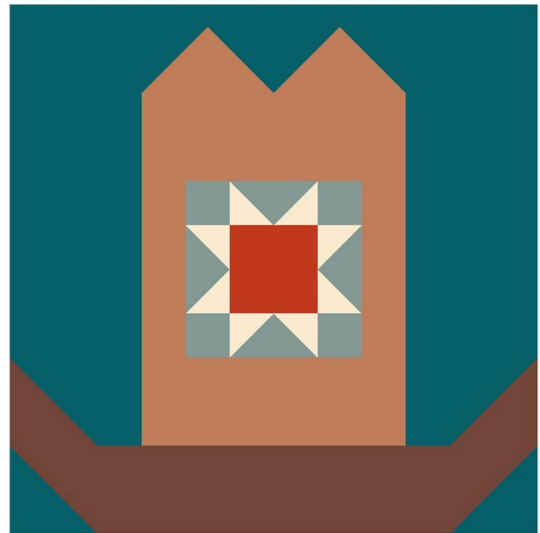


# Ten Gallon Hat

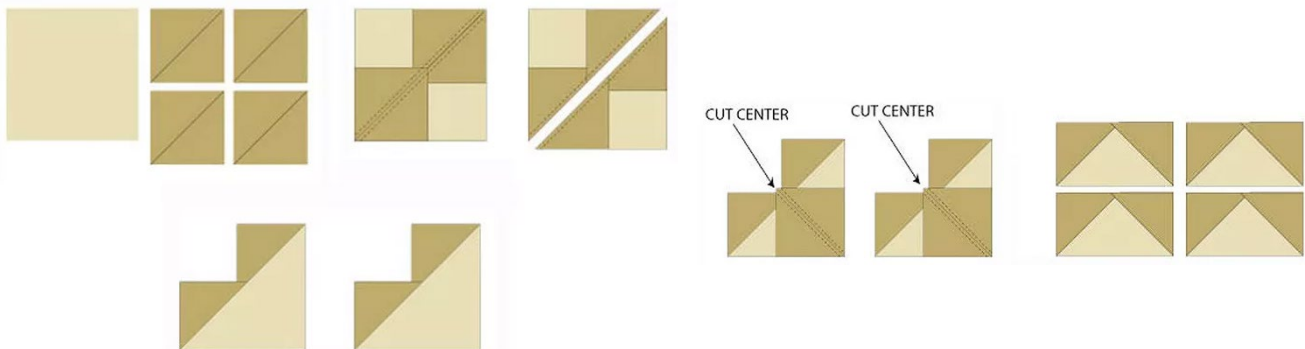
## COLORWORKS Requirements:

Red (593)	1 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" square
Cream (314)	4 – 1 7/8" x 1 7/8" squares
Lt. Teal (748)	1 – 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" square 4 – 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares
Lt Brown (371)	2 – 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles 2 – 2 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles 2 – 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips
Dk Teal (681)	2 – 3 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles 2 – 2 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles 4 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares
Dk Brown (384)	1 – 1 ½" x 12 ½" strip 2 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares



## Instructions:

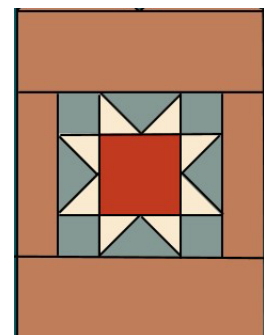
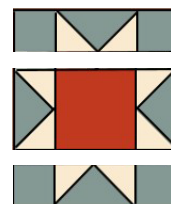
1. Using the Lt Teal 3 ¼" square and the four Cream 1 7/8" squares make four Flying Geese units using the 4-at-a-Time method as shown below. Trim each unit to 2" x 1".



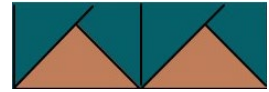
2. Sew a Flying Geese unit to opposite sides of the 2 ½" Red center square.

3. Sew a 1 ½" Lt Teal square to both ends of the remaining two Flying Geese units. Then sew these strips to the top & bottom of the center square.

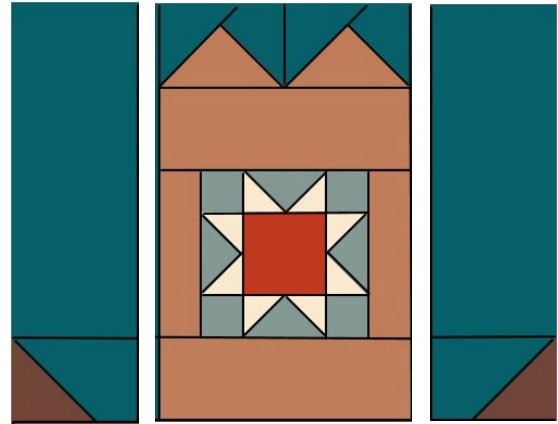
4. Sew a 1 ½" x 4 ½" Lt Brown strip to both sides of the center unit and a 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle to the top & bottom.



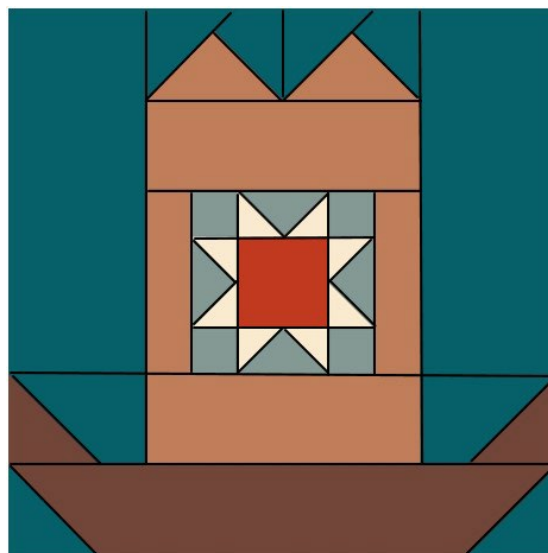
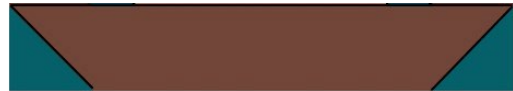
5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 4 - 2 ½" Dk Teal squares. Place a square on one end of a 2 ½" x 3 ½" Lt Brown rectangle with right sides together. Sew along the drawn line. Trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open the seam and press. Place another square on the other end and sew, cut and press in the same manner. Repeat to make two units. Sew units together and sew to the top edge of the center unit.



6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2 - 2 ½" Dk Brown squares. Place one in the bottom left corner of a 3 ½" x 10 ½" Dk Teal rectangle, right sides together, and one in the bottom right corner of the other 3 ½" x 10 ½" Dk Teal rectangle. Sew along the drawn lines. Trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open the seams and press. Sew these units to each side of the center unit.



7. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2 - 2 ½" Dk Teal squares. Place one at each end of the 2 ½" x 12 ½" Dk Brown strip. Sew along the drawn lines. Trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open the seams and press. Sew this unit to the bottom edge to complete the block.



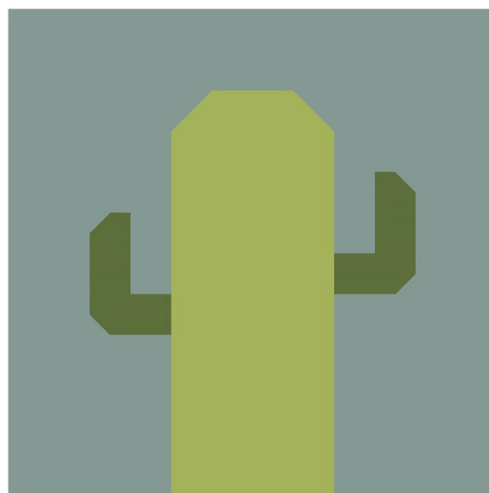
# Cactus Cutie

## COLORWORKS Requirements:

Lt. Teal (748)      2 – 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips  
                          1 – 2 ½" x 5 ½" rectangle  
                          1 – 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle  
                          1 – 2 ½" x 3 ½" rectangle  
                          1 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" square  
                          2 – 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles  
                          2 – 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares  
                          4 – 1" x 1" squares

Lt Green (741)      1 – 4 ½" x 10 ½" strip

Dk Green (792)      4 – 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles

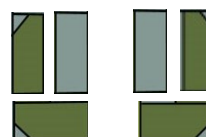


## Instructions:

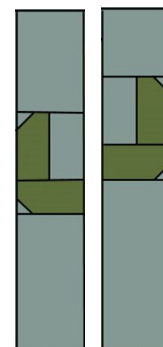
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2 – 1 ½" Lt Teal squares. Place these in the top right & left corners of the 4 ½" x 10 ½" Lt Green strip. Sew along the drawn lines. Trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open the seams and press.



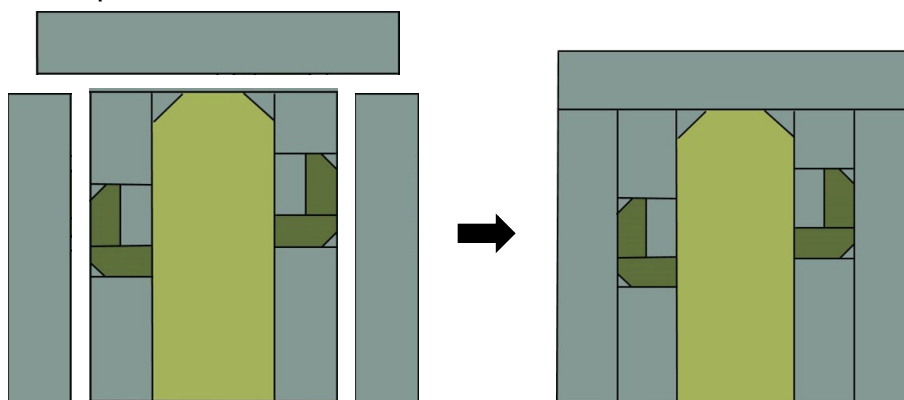
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 4 – 1" Lt Teal squares. Place two in the top right corner of 2 – 1 ½" x 2 ½" Dk Green rectangles and two in the top left corner of the remaining 2 – 1 ½" x 2 ½" Dk Green rectangles. Sew along the drawn lines. Trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open the seams and press. Sew these units together with a 1 ½" x 2 ½" Lt Teal rectangle, as shown.



3. Sew a 2 ½" x 3 ½" Lt Teal rectangle to the top edge of the left branch and a 2 ½" x 4 ½" Lt Teal rectangle to the bottom edge. Then sew a 2 ½" Lt Teal square to the top edge of the right branch and a 2 ½" x 5 ½" Lt Teal rectangle to the bottom edge, as shown.



4 Sew these units to each side of the center Lt Green rectangle. Then sew a 2 ½" x 10 ½" Lt Teal strip to each side, followed by a 2 ½" x 12 ½" to the top edge to complete the block.



# Stompin' Boot

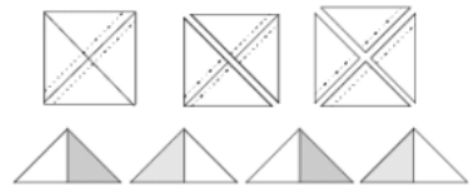
## COLORWORKS Requirements:

Red (593)	2 – 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips 2 – 3 ½" x 10 ½" strips 1 – 2 ½" x 8 ½" strip 1 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" square 4 – 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares
Dk Teal (681)	1 – 2 ¼" x 2 ¼" square 2 – 1 7/8" square 1 – 1 ½" x 1 ½" square
Cream (314)	1 – 2 ¼" x 2 ¼" square 2 – 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares
Dk Tan (122)	1 – 4 ½" x 5 ½" rectangle 1 – 2 ½" x 5 ½" rectangle 1 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" square 1 – 1 ½" x 5 ½" strip 2 – 1 ½" x 3 ½" strips



## Instructions:

1. Draw two diagonal lines on the wrong side of the 2 ¼" Cream square. Pair with the 2 ¼" Dk Teal square with right sides together and sew ¼" seam on each side of one of the drawn lines. Cut on both drawn lines. Open seams and press to the darker side to yield four quarter square triangles.



2. Cut the 2 – 1 7/8" Dk Teal squares once on the diagonal to yield four half square triangles. Pair each of these with a quarter square triangle made in the previous step. Sew together, open seams and press to the darker side to yield four Y-block units.

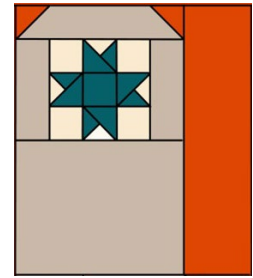


3. Arrange the Y-block units with 1 – 1 ½" Dk Teal square and 4 – 1 ½" Cream squares as shown. Sew blocks together in each row. Then sew rows together to complete the center unit.

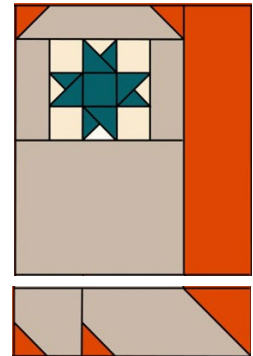


4. Sew a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Dk Tan strip to each side of the center unit.

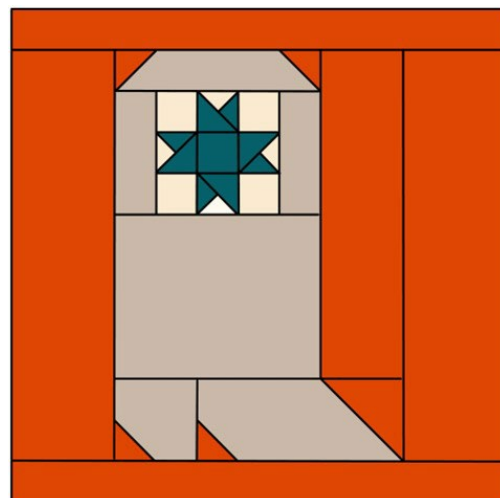
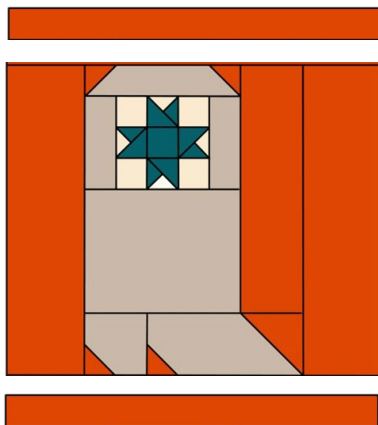
5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 2 –  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Red squares. Place one on each end of the  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Dk Tan strip. Sew along the drawn lines. Trim a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Open the seams and press. Sew this strip to the top edge of the center unit. Then sew the  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Dk Tan rectangle to the bottom edge and the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Red strip to the right side edge.



6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the remaining 2 –  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Red squares and the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Red square. Place a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square in the bottom left corner of the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Dk Tan square and the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Dk Tan rectangle, and the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Red square in the top right corner of the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Dk Tan rectangle, with right sides together. Sew along the marked lines. Trim a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Open the seams and press. Sew these two units together and then add to the bottom edge of the center unit, as shown.



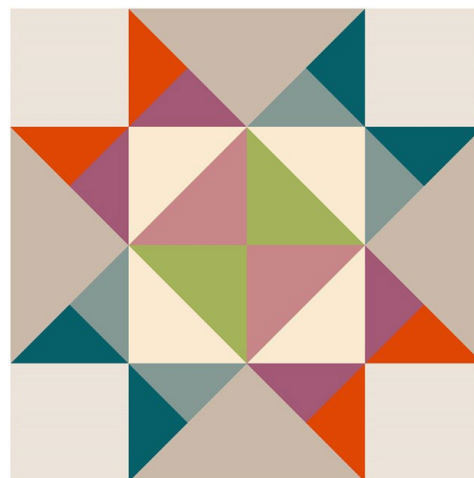
7. Sew a  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Red strip to each side of the center unit. Then add a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Red strip to the top & bottom to complete the block.



# Desert Star

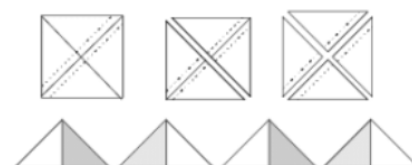
## COLORWORKS Requirements:

Lt Teal (748)	1 – 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" square
Dk Teal (681)	1 – 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" square
Dk Rose (263)	1 – 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" square
Red (593)	1 – 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" square
Dk Tan (122)	4 – 3 7/8" squares
Cream (314)	2 – 4" x 4" squares
Lt Green (741)	1 – 4" x 4" square
Lt Rose (262)	1 – 4" x 4" square
Lt Tan (122)	4 – 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares



## Instructions:

1. Draw two diagonal lines on the wrong side of the 4 ¼" Lt Teal square. Pair with the 4 ¼" Dk Teal square with right sides together and sew ¼" seam on each side of one of the drawn lines. Cut on both drawn lines. Open seams and press to the darker side to yield four quarter square triangles.



2. Repeat Step 1 using the 4 ¼" Red and Dk Rose squares.

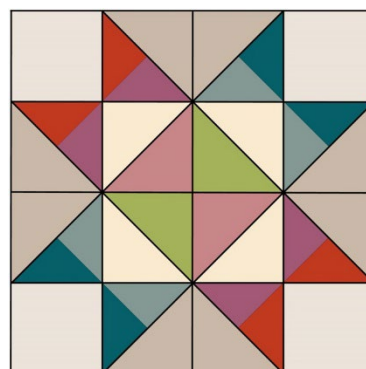
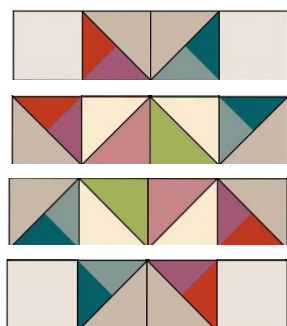
3. Cut the 4 – 3 7/8" Dk Tan squares once on the diagonal to yield four half square triangles. Pair each of these with a quarter square triangle made in the previous steps. Sew together, open seams and press to the darker side to yield four Y-block units in each colorway.



4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2 – 4" Cream squares. Pair these with the 4" Lt Green and Lt Rose squares, right sides together. Sew a ¼" from each side of the drawn line, then cut on the drawn line. Open seams and press to the darker side to yield two HST units in each colorway.



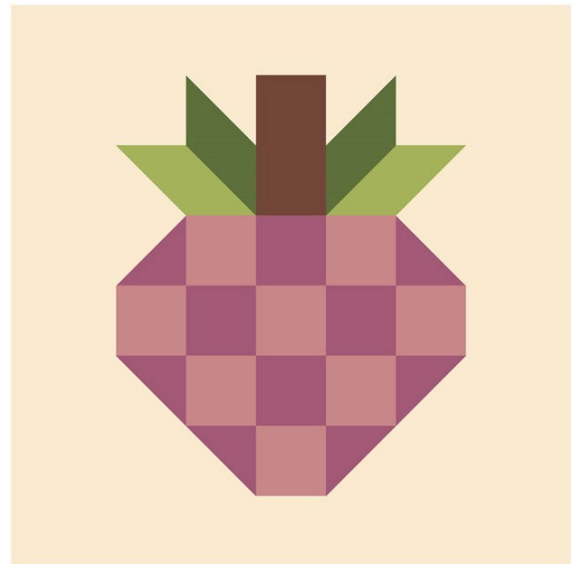
5. Referring to the finished block image, lay out the units, adding a 3 ½" Lt Tan square in each corner. Sew units together in each row, then sew rows together to complete the block.



# Summer Strawberry

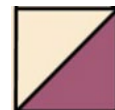
## COLORWORKS Requirements:

Cream (314)	2 – 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 9 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " strips 2 – 2" x 12 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " strips 4 – 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " squares 6 – 2" x 2" squares
Lt Rose (262)	8 – 2" x 2" squares
Dk Rose (263)	3 – 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " squares 4 – 2" x 2" squares
Lt Green (741)	1 – 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " square 2 – 2" x 2" squares
Dk Green (792)	2 – 2" x 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " rectangles
Brown (384)	1 – 2" x 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " rectangle



## Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 4 – 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Cream squares. Pair each with the 3 – 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Dk Rose squares and 1 – 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Lt Green square with right sides together. Sew a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" from each side of the drawn line, then cut on the drawn line. Open seams and press to the darker side to yield eight HST units.

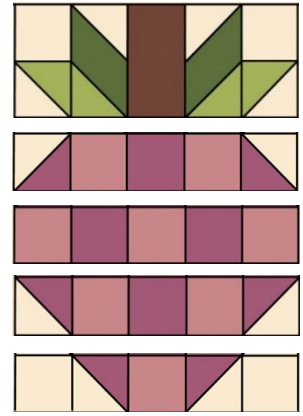

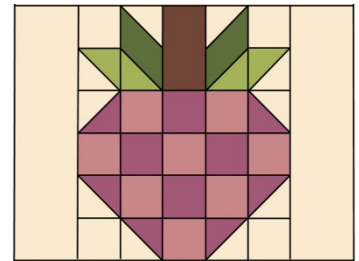
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of two of the 2" Cream squares and 2 – 2" Lt Green squares. Place a Cream square in the top left corner of 1 – 2" x 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Dk Green rectangle and a Lt Green square in the bottom right corner. Sew along the drawn lines and trim <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowance. Open seams and press. Make a second unit in the same manner, placing the Cream square in the top right corner and the Lt Green square in the lower left corner.



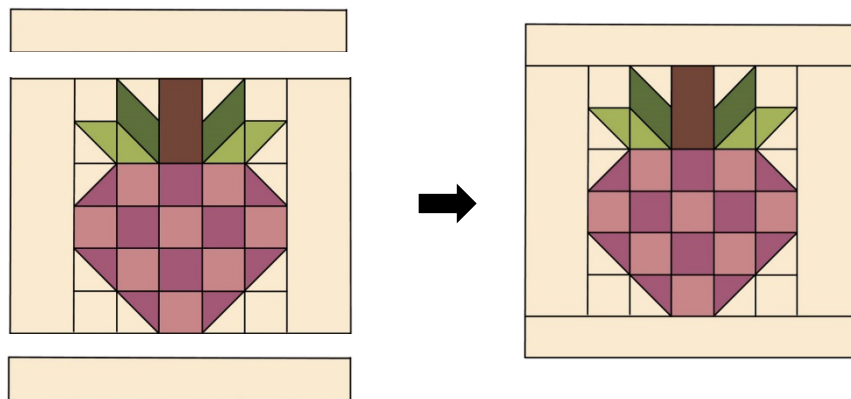
3. Referring to the finished block image, arrange units as shown.  
Sew units in each row together, then sew rows together to complete the strawberry.



4. Sew a  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Cream strip to each side of the center unit.



5. Then add a 2" x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Cream strip to the top and bottom to complete the block.





# Cozy Campfire

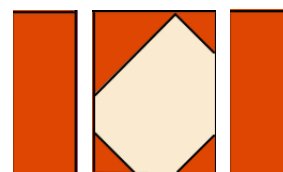
## COLORWORKS Requirements:

Cream (314)	1 – 3 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle
Red (593)	1 – 2 ½" x 6 ½" strip 1 – 1 ½" x 6 ½" strip 1 – 4 ½" x 4 ½" square 2 – 2" x 4 ½" rectangles 1 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" square 3 – 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares
Lt Rose (262)	1 – 3 ½" x 7 ½" strip 2 – 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares
Dk Rose (263)	1 – 3 ½" x 9 ½" strip 2 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares 2 – 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares
Dk Brown (384)	1 – 1 ½" x 12 ½" strip
Dk Teal (681)	1 – 4 ½" x 4 ½" square 1 – 4 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle 1 – 4 ½" x 1 ½" strip 2 – 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares 1 – 3 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle 2 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares 3 – 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares 4 – ½" x ½" squares



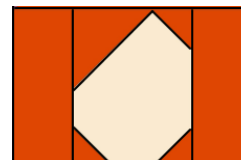
## Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1 ½" & 2 ½" Red squares. Place them in the appropriate corners of the 3 ½" x 4 ½" Cream rectangle with right sides together. Sew along the drawn lines and trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open seams and press.



2. Sew a 2" x 4 ½" Red strip to each side of the unit just made.

3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 1 ½" Lt & Dk Rose square. Place the Dk Rose square on the left bottom corner of the 1 ½" x 6 ½" Red strip and the Lt Rose square on the right bottom corner with right sides together. Sew along the drawn lines and trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open seams and press. Sew this to the bottom edge of the unit.



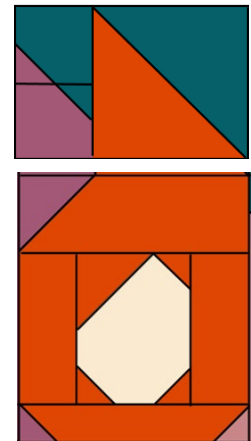
4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 – 2 ½" Dk Rose square. Place it in the top left corner of the 2 ½" x 6 ½" Red strip with right sides together. Sew along the drawn line and trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open seam and press. Sew this to the top edge of the unit.



5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 1 ½" Dk Rose & Dk Teal square. Place the Dk Rose square on the left bottom corner of a 2 ½" Dk Teal square and the Dk Teal square on the top right corner with right sides together. Sew along the drawn lines and trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open seams and press. Sew these units together as shown.

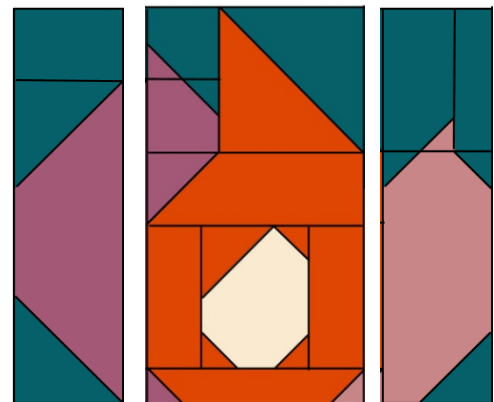


6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 4 ½" Red square. Place it on top of the 4 ½" Dk Teal square with right sides together. Sew along the drawn line and trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open seam and press. Sew this to the right side of the unit made in Step 5, then sew that to the unit made in previous steps.

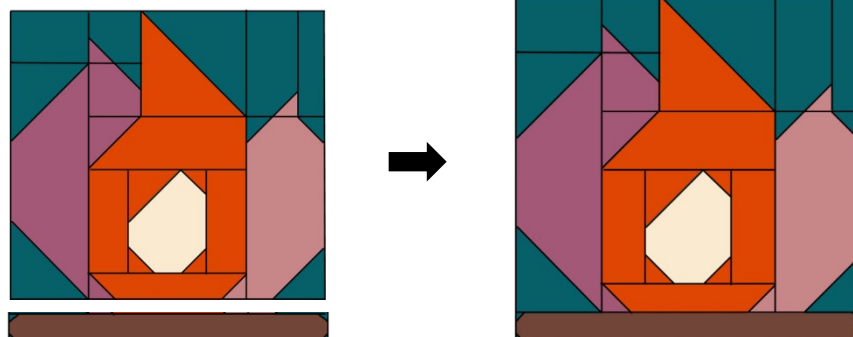


7. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2 – 3 ½" Dk Teal squares. Place in the top & bottom left corners of the 3 ½" x 9 ½" Dk Rose strip with right sides together. Sew along the drawn line and trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open seam and press. Then sew a 2 ½" x 3 ½" Dk Teal rectangle to the top short edge.

8. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 2 – 1 ½" & 1 – 2 ½" Dk Teal squares. Place in the top corners and bottom right corner of the 3 ½" x 7 ½" Lt Rose strip as shown. Sew along the drawn line and trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open seam and press. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the remaining 1 ½" Lt Rose square. Place this in the lower right corner of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Dk Teal rectangle with right sides together. Sew along the drawn line and trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open seam and press. Add a 1 ½" x 4 ½" Dk Teal trip to the right side as shown. Sew these two strips to each side of the center unit as shown.



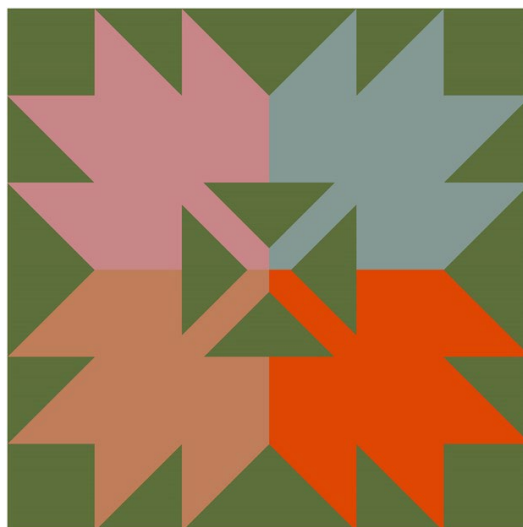
9. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 4 – ½" Dk Teal squares. Place one in each corner of the 1 ½" x 12 ½" Dk Brown strip with right sides together. Sew along the drawn lines and trim a ¼" seam allowance. Open seams and press. Sew this strip to the bottom edge of the unit to complete the block.



# Fallen Leaves

## COLORWORKS Requirements:

Dk Green (792)	4 – 4" x 4" squares 8 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares
Lt Rose (262)	1 – 4" x 4" square 1 – 4 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle 1 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" square 1 – ¾" x 3 ½" strip
Lt Teal (748)	1 – 4" x 4" square 1 – 4 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle 1 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" square 1 – ¾" x 3 ½" strip
Red (593)	1 – 4" x 4" square 1 – 4 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle 1 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" square 1 – ¾" x 3 ½" strip
Lt Brown (371)	1 – 4" x 4" square 1 – 4 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle 1 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" square 1 – ¾" x 3 ½" strip



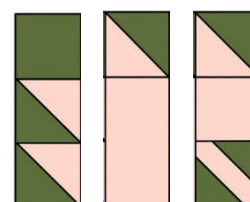
## Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 4" square in each color (Lt Rose, Lt Teal, Red & Lt Brown). Pair each with a 4" Dk Green square with right sides together. Sew a ¼" from each side of the drawn line, then cut on the drawn line. Open seams and press to the darker side to yield four HST units in each color.

2. Cut four of the 2 ½" Dk Green squares once on the diagonal to yield eight triangles. Center and sew a ¾" x 3 ½" strip between two Dk Green triangles. Trim to 2 ½" square. Repeat to make one Stem unit in each of the four colors.



3. Referring to the finished block image, arrange the HST units and Stem unit with a 2 ½" Dk Green corner square, a 2 ½" color square and a 4 ½" x 2 ½" color rectangle, as shown. Sew units together in each column. Then sew columns together to complete the Leaf unit. Repeat in each color to make four Leaf units.



4. Referring to the finished block image, arrange the Leaf units with the stems meeting in the center. Sew the top two & bottom two units together, then sew the rows together to complete the block.
