







FREE PATTERN • Table Runner • 48" x 14" by Northcott Studio

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Finished Size: $14'' \times 48''$ WOF = width of fabric; LOF = length of fabric All seams are sewn using a $\frac{1}{4}''$ seam allowance unless otherwise stated.

Fabric requirements	Yardage	Cutting Instructions
Fabric A DP22888-24	1 - 28" Panel	 From the panel, trim two placemats to 14" x 19" each From the panel, trim the two red blocks to 5" x 5" (1/4" beyond the edges of the block)
Fabric B 22885-11	½ yard	 Cut one (1) - 5" x WOF strip Sub-cut three (3) - 2" x 5" strips and two (2) - 3 ¹/₂" x 14" strips Cut four (4) - 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Set aside for binding.
Backing 22882-24	¾ yard	• Cut in half across LOF to get two (2) – 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 27" pieces.

Runner Assembly:

- 1. Sew a 2" x 5" fabric B strip between the two 5" red panel blocks. Add a 2" x 5" fabric B strip to the opposite ends of the 5" blocks. Refer to image for the direction of the floral print. Press all seams toward the red blocks.
- 2. Sew a 3 1/2" x 14" fabric B strip to each side of the unit made in step 1 to complete the center unit. Press seams toward the strips. Center unit should measure 14" x 10 1/2".
- 3. Join the short ends of the two placemat pieces to either end of the center unit, again referring to image for direction of each piece.
- 4. To prepare the backing, join the short ends of the two (2) $21 \frac{1}{2}x 27$ pieces together using a $\frac{1}{2}$ seam to get a backing piece measuring $21 \frac{1}{2}x 53$. Press seam open.
- 5. Layer top, batting & backing. Quilt & bind as desired. Your Table Runner is complete!

Use the remainder of the panel to make two placemats & two coasters for a complete table set!
