














Finished Size: 50" x 70"

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = right sides together

All seams are sewn using a ¼" seam allowance

Diagrams are shown in Colorway 1; Colorway 2 is made in the same manner.

Fabric A F9030-43 	Fabric A F9030-43 	1/3 yd	Cut 1 – 10 ½" x WOF strip ○ Sub-cut 2 – 10 ½" squares
Fabric B F9030-88 	Fabric B F9030-27 	7/8 yd	Cut 1 – 10 ½" x WOF strip ○ Sub-cut 4 – 10 ½" squares Cut 7 – 2 ¼" x WOF strips (set aside for Binding)
Fabric C F9030-49 	Fabric C F9030-49 	2/3 yd	Cut 2 – 10 ½" x WOF strips Sub-cut 5 – 10 ½" squares
Fabric D F9030-64 	Fabric D F9030-78 	1/3 yd	Cut 1 – 10 ½" x WOF strip ○ Sub-cut 4 – 10 ½" squares
Fabric E F9030-68 	Fabric E F9030-34 	1/3 yd	Cut 1 – 10 ½" x WOF strip ○ Sub-cut 2 – 10 ½" squares
Fabric F F9030-93 	Fabric F F9030-11 	1 yd	Cut 6 – 5 ½" x WOF strips
Fabric G F9030-96 	Fabric G F9030-15 	½ yd	Cut 3 – 5 ½" x WOF strips
Fabric H F9030-99 	Fabric H F9030-36 	½ yd	Cut 3 – 5 ½" x WOF strips
Crosswise Backing F9030-96 	Crosswise Backing F9030-15 	3 ¼ yds	Cut the length of fabric in half to get 2 – 58 ½" x WOF pieces. With right sides together, join the two pieces across the selvage edges for a backing piece measuring approximately 58" x 85"

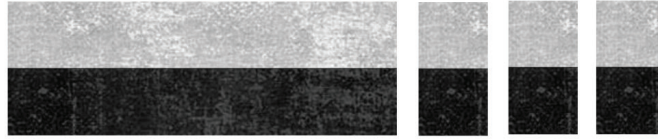
### Block Assembly:

1. Sew together a 5 ½" x WOF Fabric F and Fabric G strip RST to make Strip Set 1, as shown below. Repeat to make three Strip Set 1's. From these strip sets, cut 18 – 5 ½" x 10 ½" Unit 1's.

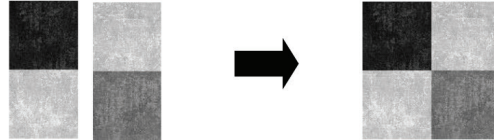




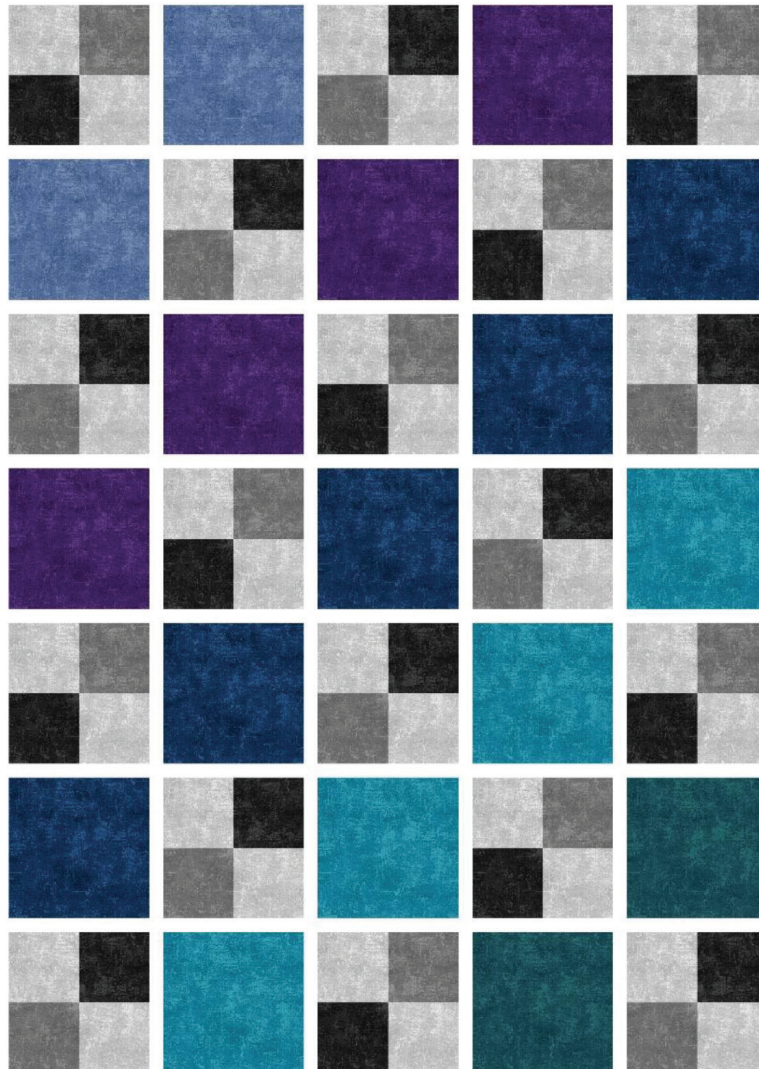
2. Sew together a 5 ½" x WOF Fabric F and Fabric H strip RST to make Strip Set 2, as shown below. Repeat to make three Strip Set 2's. From these strip sets, cut 18 – 5 ½" x 10 ½" Unit 2's.



3. Arrange a Unit 1 & Unit 2 as shown below. Sew units together to make the Four-Square Block. Repeat to make 18 Four-Square Blocks.



4. Alternating four-square blocks and solid blocks as shown below, and turning every other four-square block, sew blocks together row by row. Then sew rows together to complete the quilt top.



5. Join the Fabric B binding strips using diagonal seams. Fold in half along the length of the strip and press.
6. Layer quilt top with batting and prepared backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
