Finished Size 50" x 70"

Four Square Throw Size Quilt in 2 Colorways

Collection: **Canvas Flannel**Finished Size: 50" x 70"
WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = right sides together

All seams are sewn using a ¼" seam allowance

Diagrams are shown in Colorway 1; Colorway 2 is made in the same manner.

Block Assembly:

1. Sew together a 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric F and Fabric G strip RST to make Strip Set 1, as shown below. Repeat to make three Strip Set 1's. From these strip sets, cut 18 – 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1's.









2. Sew together a 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric F and Fabric H strip RST to make Strip Set 2, as shown below. Repeat to make three Strip Set 2's. From these strip sets, cut $18 - 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 2's.



3. Arrange a Unit 1 & Unit 2 as shown below. Sew units together to make the Four-Square Block. Repeat to make 18 Four-Square Blocks.



4. Alternating four-square blocks and solid blocks as shown below, and turning every other four-square block, sew blocks together row by row. Then sew rows together to complete the quilt top.



- 5. Join the Fabric B binding strips using diagonal seams. Fold in half along the length of the strip and press.
- 6. Layer quilt top with batting and prepared backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
