





# **CREATION WALL HANGING & RUNNER SET**

Free Pattern by Northcott Studio
Wall Hanging 31" x 37" and Runner 15" x 28"

## **Creation Wall Hanging & Runner Set**

Fabric Collection – *Creation*Finished Sizes – Wall Hanging 31" x 37"; Runner 15" x 28"
WOF = width of fabric
All seams sewn using ¼" seam allowance

#### **Requirements:**

| Fabric                     | Yardage          | Cutting Instructions   |
|----------------------------|------------------|--|
| DP25020-68<br>Main         | 2/3 yd (1 Panel) | See instructions below.  |
| DP25021-24<br>Inner Border | 1/3 yd           | Cut 3 – 1 ½" x WOF strips<br>Cut 3 – 1" x WOF strips                 |
| 25024-66<br>Outer Border   | 5/8 yd           | Cut 3 – 3 ½" x WOF strips<br>Cut 3 – 2 ½" x WOF strips               |
| DP25025-68<br>Binding      | 1/2 yd           | Cut 7 – 2 ¼" x WOF strips  |
| 25024-66<br>Backing        | 1 ½ yds          | Cut fabric into two backing pieces measuring 36" x WOF and 18" x WOF |

## **Instructions for Wall Hanging:**

- 1. Trim main part of panel to 23 ½" x 29 ½".
- 2. Join the  $3-1\,\%$ " x WOF inner border strips end to end. From this long strip, cut  $2-29\,\%$ " strips and sew one to each side of the panel. Then cut  $2-25\,\%$ " strips and sew to the top & bottom of the panel.
- 3. Join the  $3-3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF outer border strips end to end. From this long strip, cut  $2-31 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sew one to each side of the quilt top. Then cut  $2-31 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sew to the top & bottom of the quilt top.
- 4. Join the 2 ¼" binding strips together using diagonal seams. Fold in half along the length of the strip and press. (This will be enough to bind both projects.)
- 5. Layer quilt top with batting & backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.

### **Instructions for Runner:**

- 1. Trim the remainder of the panel to  $10 \frac{1}{2}$  x  $23 \frac{1}{2}$ .
- 2. Join the 3-1" x WOF inner border strips end to end. From this long strip, cut 2-23 %" strips and sew to the top & bottom of the panel piece. Then cut 2-11 %" strips and sew to each side of the panel piece.
- 3. Join the  $3 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF outer border strips end to end. From this long strip, cut  $2 24 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sew to the top & bottom of the quilt top. Then cut  $2 15 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sew to each side of the quilt top.
- 4. Layer quilt top with batting & backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
