All seams are sewn using a ¼" seam allowance WOF = width of fabric 5" Finished Blocks

Requirements & Cutting Instructions:

Fabric		Yardage	Cutting Instructions
Fabric A SOPULE40-10	S Targ	1 Strip Roll (40 – 2 ½" strips)	N/A
Fabric B P10091-10 (Glisten)		3 yds	Cut 18 – 1 ½" x WOF strips Sub-cut 126 – 1 ½" x 5 ½" sashing strips Cut 46 – 1 ½" x WOF strips
Fabric C 10359P-71		2/3 yd	Cut 8 – 2 ½" x WOF strips; Set aside for binding
Lengthwise Backing 10359P-59		6 yds	Cut in half along length of fabric to get 2 – 3 yd pieces. Sew pieces together along the selvage edges.

Instructions:

1. Lay out the $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips in pairs of two, as desired. Sew each pair together with a $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip in between to create 40 strip sets as shown.



2. Sub-cut each strip set into 7 - 5 ½" x 5 ½" segments to complete the blocks. You will have a total of 140 blocks.



- 3. Arrange blocks into 14 rows of 10 blocks each, turning every other block in the opposite direction.
- 4. Sew blocks in each row together, adding a $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B sashing strip between each block to complete 14 rows.



- 5. Join the remaining 1%" x WOF Fabric B strips end to end and sub-cut 15 1%" x 59 %" horizontal sashing and top & bottom border strips, and 2 1%" x 85 %" side border strips.
- 6. Sew rows together with a horizontal sashing strip between each row, then add the top & bottom border strips.
- 7. Sew a side border strip to each side to complete the quilt top.
- 8. Join the Fabric C binding strips using diagonal seams. Trim seams to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Fold in half, wrong sides together, along the length of the strip, and press.
- 9. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
