## Cabin in the Canyon

Finished Size: $681 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 861 / 2 \prime$
Number of Blocks \& Finished Size: 24 brown \& 24 rust blocks, all 9" finished
Wof = width of fabric

| Fabric Requirements | Yards | Cutting Instructions |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| A - lengthwise border stripe \#39133-37 | 17/8yds | $\diamond$ Cut 4 lengthwise strips $97 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ wide; cut into (24) $97 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut 12 squares once diagonally from top right to bottom left, and 12 squares once diagonally from top left to bottom right. |
| B - outer border \#39134-37 | 15/8yds | $\diamond$ Cut 8 strips 61/2" x wof; join end-to-end in pairs, and trim 2 to $74112^{\prime \prime}$ and 2 to $681 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. |
| C - darkest brown inner border \& blocks \#39140-37 | 15/8yds | $\diamond$ Cut 7 strips $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ wof; join end-to-end and cut (2) $72 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ pieces \& (2) $561 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. <br> $\checkmark$ Cut 1 strip $83 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof \& 1 strip $93 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ pieces. <br> $\checkmark$ Cut 9 strips $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ wof; join end-to-end, press in half and reserve for binding |
| D - brown $2^{\text {nd }}$ darkest round \#39080-37 | 1/2yd | $\diamond$ Cut 1 strip 63/4" x wof \& 1 strip 73/4" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 11⁄2" pieces. |
| E-brown $3^{\text {rd }}$ darkest round \#39060-53 | 3/8yd | $\diamond$ Cut 1 strip 43/4" x wof \& 1 strip 53/4" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 112" pieces. |
| F - brown lightest round \#3934-12 | 1/4yd | $\diamond$ Cut 1 strip $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof \& 1 strip $33 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. |
| $\begin{aligned} & \text { G - block center } \\ & \text { \#39139-37 } \end{aligned}$ | 1/4yd | $\diamond$ Cut 3 strips 13/4" $\times$ wof; cut into (48) $13 / 4$ " squares. |
| H - dark rust \#39060-37 | 5/8yd | $\diamond$ Cut 1 strip $83 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof \& 1 strip $93 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. |
| $1-2^{\text {nd }}$ darkest rust round \#39137-37 | 1/2yd | $\diamond$ Cut 1 strip 63/4" x wof \& 1 strip 73/4" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 11⁄2" pieces. |
| J - $3^{\text {rd }}$ darkest rust round \#39136-37 | 3/8yd | $\diamond$ Cut 1 strip 43/4" x wof \& 1 strip 53/4" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 112" pieces. |
| K - rust lightest round \#3954-151 | 1/4yd | $\diamond$ Cut 1 strip $23 / 4$ x wof \& 1 strip $33 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 11⁄2" pieces. |
| Backing | 51/3yds | $\diamond$ Cut into 2 equal lengths and join edge-to-edge. |
| Batting | A piece 72" $\times$ 90" |  |

## Piecing:

1. Lay out all of the brown block pieces in order from shortest to longest (F, E, D, \& C).
2. Sew a $23 / 4$ " F piece onto 24 G squares, aligning one end with

square. Press seam toward F.
3. Sew the $33 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ F piece onto adjacent side of $G$ as shown; press seam toward $F$.
4. Continue, adding the shorter $E$, longer $E$, shorter $D$, longer $D$, shorter $C$, then longer $C$ pieces.
5. Repeat steps 1-4 using the rust block pieces ( $\mathrm{K}, \mathrm{J}, \mathrm{I} \& \mathrm{H}$ ).
6. Divide the half-log cabin units into 4 piles, placing 6 rust and 6 brown units in each pile.
7. Arrange the A triangles into 4 piles: top right, bottom left, top left, and bottom right.
8. Working with one A pile and one rust/brown pile at a time, place an A triangle right side down on each rust or brown half-log cabin unit, aligning the straight edges. Stitch $1 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ " from the angled edge of the triangle. Trim off excess points of the half-log cabin, and press seam toward A.

## Assembly:

1. Using the photo as a guide, lay out the blocks in concentric rows of rust and brown, using all of the top right blocks in the top right corner of the quilt, the top left ones in the top left corner and so on.
2. Sew the blocks into rows, then sew the rows together.
3. Sew the $72^{11 / 2 \prime}$ C strips to each side, then the $561 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ C strips to top and bottom edges, pressing seams toward C .
4. Sew the $741 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strips to each side, then the $681 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strips to top and bottom edges, pressing seams toward $B$.

## Finishing:

Layer the prepared backing, batting and quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired. Trim edges even with quilt top. Sew the prepared binding to the edges, turn and stitch in place.
