

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## Cabin in the Canyon

**Finished Size:** 68½" x 86½"

Number of Blocks & Finished Size: 24 brown & 24 rust blocks, all 9" finished


Wof = width of fabric

Fabric Requirements	Yards	Cutting Instructions
<b>A</b> – lengthwise border	1‰yds	♦ Cut 4 lengthwise strips 9 <sup>%</sup> wide; cut into (24) 9 <sup>%</sup> squares. Cut 12 squares once
stripe <b>#39133-37</b>	1/8905	diagonally from top right to bottom left, and 12 squares once diagonally from top
stripe #33133-37		left to bottom right.
<b>B</b> – outer border	1%yds	♦ Cut 8 strips 6½" x wof; join end-to-end in pairs, and trim 2 to 74½" and 2 to 68½".

C – darkest brown -	1%yds	♦ Cut 7 strips 1½" x wof; join end-to-end and cut (2) 72½" pieces & (2) 56½" pieces.
inner border & blocks		◊ Cut 1 strip 8¾" x wof & 1 strip 9¾" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 1½" pieces.
#39140-37		♦ Cut 9 strips 2½" x wof; join end-to-end, press in half and reserve for binding
<b>D</b> – brown 2 <sup>nd</sup> darkest	½yd	◊ Cut 1 strip 6¾" x wof & 1 strip 7¾" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 1½" pieces.
round <b>#39080-37</b>		
E –brown 3 <sup>rd</sup> darkest	3∕8yd	◊ Cut 1 strip 4¾" x wof & 1 strip 5¾" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 1½" pieces.
round <b>#39060-53</b>		
<b>F</b> – brown lightest	¼yd	◊ Cut 1 strip 2¾" x wof & 1 strip 3¾" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 1½" pieces.
round <b>#3934-12</b>		
G – block center	¼yd	♦ Cut 3 strips 1¾" x wof; cut into (48) 1¾" squares.

H – dark rust #39060-37	⁵%yd	◊ Cut 1 strip 8¾" x wof & 1 strip 9¾" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 1½" pieces.
I – 2 <sup>nd</sup> darkest rust	½yd	◊ Cut 1 strip 6¾" x wof & 1 strip 7¾" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 1½" pieces.
round <b>#39137-37</b>		
J – 3 <sup>rd</sup> darkest rust	3∕8yd	◊ Cut 1 strip 4¾" x wof & 1 strip 5¾" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 1½" pieces.
round <b>#39136-37</b>		
K – rust lightest round	¼yd	◊ Cut 1 strip 2¾" x wof & 1 strip 3¾" x wof; cross-cut each strip into (24) 1½" pieces.

Backing	5⅓yds	♦ Cut into 2 equal lengths and join edge-to-edge.
Batting	A piece 72" x 90"	

#### **Piecing:**

**1.** Lay out all of the brown block pieces in order from shortest to longest (F, E, D, & C).

Sew a 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" F piece onto 24 G squares, aligning one end with square. Press seam toward F.



**3.** Sew the 3¾" F piece onto adjacent side of G as shown; press seam toward F.

- 4. Continue, adding the shorter E, longer E, shorter D, longer D, shorter C, then longer C pieces.
- **5.** Repeat steps 1-4 using the rust block pieces (K, J, I & H).
- 6. Divide the half-log cabin units into 4 piles, placing 6 rust and 6 brown units in each pile.

7. Arrange the A triangles into 4 piles: top right, bottom left, top left, and bottom right.

**8.** Working with one A pile and one rust/brown pile at a time, place an A triangle right side down on each rust or brown half-log cabin unit, aligning the straight edges. Stitch ¼" from the angled edge of the triangle. Trim off excess points of the half-log cabin, and press seam toward A.

### Assembly:

**1.** Using the photo as a guide, lay out the blocks in concentric rows of rust and brown, using all of the top right blocks in the top right corner of the quilt, the top left ones in the top left corner and so on.

2. Sew the blocks into rows, then sew the rows together.

**3.** Sew the 72½" C strips to each side, then the 56½" C strips to top and bottom edges, pressing seams toward C.

**4.** Sew the 74½" B strips to each side, then the 68½" B strips to top and bottom edges, pressing seams toward B.

#### Finishing:

Layer the prepared backing, batting and quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired. Trim edges even with quilt top. Sew the prepared binding to the edges, turn and stitch in place.
