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# Frost Bite Baby Quilt 

Finished Size: $371 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
WOF = width of fabric; LOF = length of fabric
All seams are sewn using a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance

| Fabric requirements | Yardage | Cutting Instructions |

| Fabric B - F22796-48 (Pink \& Blue Versions) | $11 / 8 \mathrm{yds}$ | - Cut three (3) - 10" $x$ LOF strips, fussy cutting the design (refer to quilt image) - for Row 1 |
| Fabric B -F22798-21 <br> (Pink) or F22799-64 <br> (Blue) | $1 / 4 \mathrm{yds}$ | - Cut one (1) $-51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip <br> - Sub-cut six (6) $-5^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ squares - for blocks in Row 2 |
| Fabric C - F22801-10 <br> (Both Colorways) | 1/4 yds | - Cut one (1) -6 " $x$ WOF strip <br> - Sub-cut four (4) -6" squares - for blocks in Row 2 |
| Fabric D - F22803-12 (Both Colorways) | 1/4yd | - Cut one (1) -6 " $\times$ WOF strip <br> - Sub-cut four (4) -6" squares - for blocks in Row 2 |
| Fabric E-F22802-21 (Pink) or F22802-64 (Blue) | 1/2 yd | - Cut eight (8) $-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips - for sashing rows \& outer border <br> - Trim four (4) of the strips to $351 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (for sashing) <br> - Leave the remaining four (4) strips WOF (for outer border) |
| Fabric F - F22800-10 (Both Colorways) | $3 / 8 \mathrm{yds}$ | - Cut five (5) - $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; set aside for binding |
| Fabric G - F22797-62 <br> (Pink) or F22797-48 <br> (Blue) | $11 / 3 \mathrm{yds}$ | - No cutting required. |

## Piecing Instructions:

1. Trim Fabric A strips to $35 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$. This completes Row 1 .
2. Using a pencil or disappearing fabric marker, draw a horizontal line from corner to corner on the four Fabric C 6 " squares. Match up a Fabric C \& D square with right sides together and sew a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the line drawn (on both sides of the line). Cut on the marked line to get two $5^{11 / 2}$ " square HST units. Repeat for all C \& D squares for a total of eight HST units.
3. Alternating the HST units made in step 2 \& the Fabric B squares, sew seven blocks together turning the HST units as needed (refer to the quilt image for placement). Make two of Row 2.

## Quilt Top Assembly:

1. Join the rows by alternating Row $1 \&$ Row 2 and adding a $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $E$ sashing strip between each row.
2. Measure the vertical length through the center of the quilt and trim the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side border strips to the same measurement. Match the center of the border strips to the center of each side of the quilt and pin. Match the ends of the border strips to both ends of the quilt and pin. Sew the seams and press towards the borders. Repeat this process for the top and bottom border using the width through the center of the quilt as your measurement guide. Press towards the borders.
3. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
