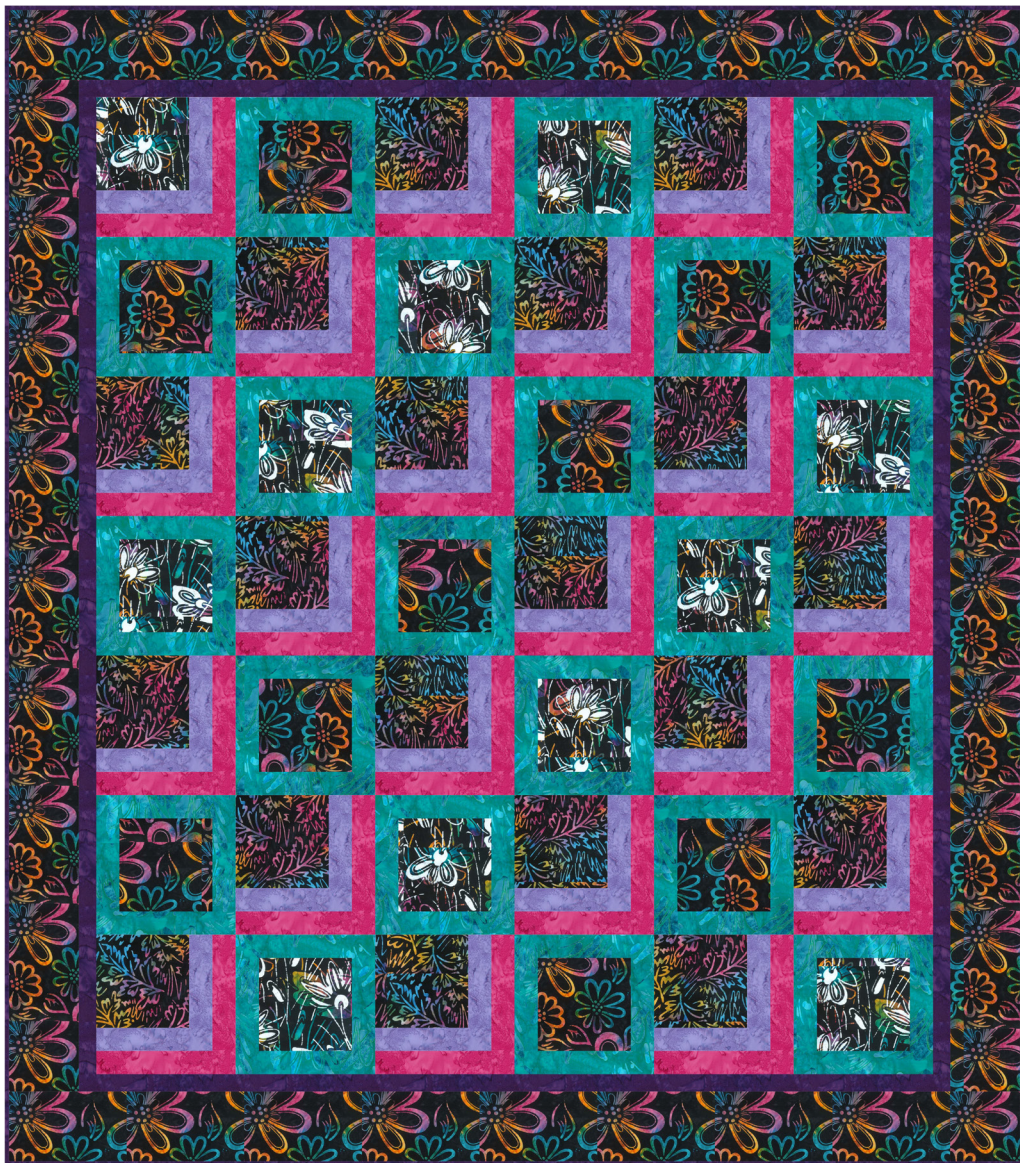



8" Finished Blocks

Skill Level: Beginner

WOF = width of fabric

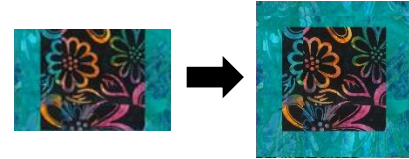
All seams sewn using a ¼" seam allowance

Requirements & Cutting:

Fabric		Yardage	Cutting Instructions
			➤
Fabric A 83080-99		1 3/8 yds	Cut 2 – 6 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 11 – 6 ½" squares Cut 6 – 4 ½" x WOF strips (for Outer Border)
Fabric B 83081-99		7/8 yd	Cut 4 – 6 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 20 – 6 ½" squares
Fabric C 83082-99		1/2 yd	Cut 2 – 6 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 11 – 6 ½" squares
Fabric D 83083-64		7/8 yd	Cut 16 – 1 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 42 – 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips and 42 – 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips
Fabric E 81300-83		1/2 yd	Cut 8 – 1 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 21 – 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips and 21 – 1 ½" x 7 ½" strips
Fabric F 81300-28		1/2 yd	Cut 9 – 1 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 21 – 1 ½" x 7 ½" strips and 21 – 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips
Fabric G 81300-86		7/8 yd	Cut 5 – 1 ½" x WOF strips (for Inner Border) Cut 7 – 2 ½" x WOF strips (for Binding)
83081-99 Crosswise Backing		4 yds	Cut in half along length of fabric to yield 2 – 72" x WOF pieces. Sew pieces together along the selvage edges.

Block 1 Assembly: (Make 21 total)

1. Using the Fabric A & C squares and the Fabric D strips, sew a 1 ½" x 6 ½" strip to the right & left side of the square, then sew a 1 ½" x 8 ½" strip to the top and bottom of the square to complete Block 1, as shown.



2. Make 11 blocks using Fabric A squares and 10 using Fabric C squares for a total of 21 Block 1's.

Block 2 Assembly: (Make 21 total)

1. Using the Fabric B squares, one remaining Fabric C square and the Fabric E & F strips, sew a 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric E strip to the right side of the square, then sew a 1 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric E strip to the bottom edge. Next, sew a 1 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric F strip to the right side of the square, and then sew a 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip to the bottom edge to complete Block 2, as shown.



2. Make 20 blocks using Fabric B squares and 1 using the remaining Fabric C square for a total of 21 Block 2's.

Quilt Top Assembly:

1. Referring to the quilt image, arrange blocks into 7 rows of 6 blocks each. Sew blocks together to complete rows, pressing seams in the opposite direction to the row above/below, i.e. Row 1 – press seams to the left; Row 2 – press seams to the right, etc.
2. Sew rows together to complete the quilt top center.
3. Join Fabric G Inner Border strips end to end. From this long strip, cut 2 – 56 ½" side border strips and 2 – 50 ½" top & bottom border strips. Sew the side borders to each side of the quilt, then add the top & bottom border strips.
4. Join Fabric A Outer Border strips end to end. From this long strip, cut 2 – 58 ½" side border strips and 2 – 66 ½" strips. Add outer borders as done in Step 3 to complete the quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt:

1. Join Fabric G Binding strips using diagonal seams. Fold in half, wrong sides together, along the length of the strip.
2. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
