Collection: MY CANADA Finished Size: 43" x 61" WOF = width of fabric

All seams are sewn using a 1/4" seam allowance

Fabric Requirements	Yardage	Cutting Instructions
Fabric A – Center	2/3 yard	Trim to 23 ½" x 41 ½"
24014-90 or 24009-92

Fabric B – Inner Border & Binding	3/4 yard	Cut 4 – 2 ½" x WOF strips
24017-24		Cut 6 – 2 ¼" x WOF strips; set aside for binding
Fabric C – Middle Border	7/8 yard	Cut 4 – 6 ½" x WOF strips
24016-92		
Fabric D – Outer Border	1/2 yd	Cut 5 – 2 ½" x WOF strips
24017-94		
Fabric E – Small Cornerstones	1/8 yd	Cut 1 – 2 ½" x WOF strip
24017-92		Sub-cut 8 – 2 ½" squares
Fabric F – Large Cornerstones	1/4 yd	Cut 1 – 6 ½" x WOF strip
24011-94		• Sub-cut 4 – 6 ½" squares
Backing	2 yds	No cutting required

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

- 1. Trim two Fabric B inner border strips to 41 ½" and sew one to each side of center panel. Press seams toward the center.
- 2. Trim two Fabric B inner border strips to 23 ½". Sew a 2 ½" x 2 ½" cornerstone to each end of both strips. Press seams toward the cornerstones. Then sew these strips to the top & bottom of the center panel, pressing the seams toward the center.
- 3. Join Fabric C border strips on the short edges. Repeat Steps 1 & 2 to attach the middle borders, measuring the <u>length</u> of the quilt through the center to determine what length to trim the side border strips and measuring the <u>width</u> of the quilt through the center to determine what length to trim the top & bottom border strips. Sew a 6 ½" x 6 ½" cornerstone to each end of the top & bottom border strips.
- 4. Join Fabric C border strips on the short edges, and add the outer borders in the same manner as above.
- 5. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt and bind as desired.
- 6. Join the binding strips end to end using diagonal seams and prepare binding. Bind using your favorite method.
