

O Christmas Tree - Tree Skirt/Table Topper Panel

Instructions for Christmas Tree Skirt:

- Layer the tree skirt onto a piece of batting and backing.
 Quilt as desired.
- Cut out the tree skirt on the scalloped edge.
- To find the center, draw two lines using a non-permanent marking tool.Draw one line connecting the arrows for line A and one line connecting the arrows for line B.
- 4. Make a 6" circle template from paper. Fold the paper in quarters to create guidelines.
- 5. Open the paper template and match the fold lines with the lines marked on the tree skirt. Trace the circle onto the tree skirt.
- 6. Make a slit in the tree skirt. Cut along ONE of the traced lines (behind the snowman to the center ONLY) and then cut out the center circle.
- 7. Bind the tree skirt with bias binding. You will need 200 inches of continuous bias binding (instructions on Northcott website).

Instructions for Christmas Table Topper:

- 1. If you want the table topper to be quilted, follow Steps 1, 2 and 7 above.
- 2. If you do NOT want the table topper to be quilted, then place the backing right sides together with the table topper.
- 3. Stitch together just inside the edge of the scallop, leaving an opening for turning.
- 4. Clip into the corners of the scallops and clip curves.
- Turn right side out, close the opening and press.
- 6. If you wish, top stitch 1/4" away from the outside edge of the table topper.
