

PINWHEEL POSIES RUNNER




WOF = width of fabric; RST = right sides together; HST = half square triangle


All seams sewn using a 1/4" seam allowance

Requirements:

Flower Petals 80750-23 -25 -28 -63  81300-22 -62 81600-28 -85 	1/8 yd each	From each fabric, Cut 1 – 3 1/2" x WOF strip ○ Sub-cut 6 – 3 1/2" squares
Corner Triangles, Outer Border & Binding 80750-25 	7/8 yd	Cut 1 – 3 1/2" x WOF strip ○ Sub-cut 6 – 3 1/2" squares & 12 – 2" squares Cut 5 – 2 1/2" x WOF strips (outer border) Cut 5 – 2 1/4" x WOF strips (binding)
Flower Centers 81300-54 	1/8 yd	Cut 2 – 1 1/2" x WOF strips ○ sub-cut 48 – 1 1/2" squares
Leaves & Stems 81600-71 	1/4 yd	Cut 1 – 5 1/2" x WOF strip ○ sub-cut 6 – 5 1/2" squares & 12 – 7/8" x 6" strips
Background & Sashing 81203-10 	1 yd	Cut 2 – 3 1/2" x WOF strips ○ Sub-cut 24 – 3 1/2" squares Cut 1 – 5 1/2" x WOF strip ○ Sub-cut 6 – 5 1/2" squares Cut 1 – 4" x WOF strip ○ Sub-cut 12 – 4" squares Cut 9 – 1 1/2" x WOF strips ○ Sub-cut 48 – 1 1/2" squares ○ For sub-cutting of sashing strips, see instructions below.
Backing 80750-25 	2 yds	No cutting required.

Block Assembly:

1. Take 1 – 3 ½” flower petal square, 1 – 1 ½” background square and 1 – 1 ½” yellow square. Place the background square onto the top left corner of the large square RST. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown below. Sew along drawn line. Cut off excess fabric ¼” above the seam line (towards the outside corner). Repeat this process with the small yellow square in the top right corner. Press seams open to complete Unit 1 as shown. Repeat with all flower petal squares to make 48 Unit 1’s.





2. Take 1 – 3 ½” background square and 1 – 2” corner triangle square. Follow the same process as in Step 1 above to make Unit 2 as shown. Repeat to make 12 Unit 2’s.

3. Take 1 – 5 ½” background square and 1 – 5 ½” green square. With RST, sew ¼” around the perimeter of the square. Cut on both diagonals and press seams open to complete four HST Units. Trim each HST to 3 ½” square. Repeat with remaining 5 ½” squares to make 24 HST Units.




HST Unit

4. Take 1 – 4” background square and 1 – 7/8” x 6” green strip. Cut the square in half on the diagonal, making two triangles. Sew the green strip between the two triangles to make a Stem Unit. Trim the unit to 3 ½” square, making sure the diagonal line of your ruler is centered along the green strip. Repeat to make 12 Stem Units.



Stem Unit


5. Arrange four Unit 1’s (2 pairs of coordinating blocks), one Unit 2, one 3 ½” background square, two HST Units and one Stem Unit as shown.



6. Sew units together to complete each row. Then sew rows together to complete the Pinwheel Posie Block.

7. Repeat Steps 1 – 6 to complete 12 Pinwheel Posie Blocks.

- From the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF sashing strips, cut 10 – $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Arrange blocks in 2 rows of 6, rotating the blocks as shown. Sew a sashing strip between each block.



- Join the remaining sashing strips together end to end. Cut 3 – $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $59\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and 2 – $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $21\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew one $59\frac{1}{2}$ " strip between the two rows and one $59\frac{1}{2}$ " strip on the other side of each row. Then sew a $21\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to each side.
- Join the 5 – $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF outer border strips together end to end. Cut 2 – $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $61\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and 2 – $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $25\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew the $61\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the top and bottom. Then sew the $25\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the sides.
- Join the 5 – $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF binding strips using diagonal seams. Fold in half wrong sides together along the length of the strip and press.
- Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
