

20-minute Pillowcase - 20" x 36"

Supplies: 11/3" yd for the pillow – cut 2 pieces 20 3/4" x 30"

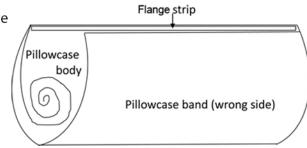
 $\frac{3}{8}$ " yd for the band – trim to 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " long x 41" wide $\frac{1}{8}$ " yd for the flange – cut a piece $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41" wide

Instructions:

1) Cut 2 pieces Rodeo panel – 2 panels will create front & back of pillowcase. Trim both panels to $20 \frac{1}{2}$ wide.

2) Cut left bands off panel using the rope as a guide. This piece will be used for the inside of the pillow band facing.

 Place panel pieces wrong sides together and stitch across bottom and sides using a scant ¼" seam.
Trim corners as shown (see picture).



- 4) Turn inside out and finger press seam to one side. Lay pillowcase flat and press sides and end seam so that the seam is at the edge. Sew a generous $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on sides and end, encasing the raw edges in the seam. Turn right side out and press seam to one side.
- 5) Turn inside out and finger-press seam to one side. Lay pillowcase flat and press side and end seams so that the seam is at the edge. Sew a generous ¼" seam on side and end, encasing the raw edges in the seam. Turn right side out and press seam to one side. You're finished!
