



Fabric Requirements & Cutting Instructions:

Colorway: Downtown / Streetscape	Yardage	Cutting Instructions
Fabric A – 83060-86 / 83060-98	3/4 yd	Cut 1 – 3" x WOF strip Sub-cut 12 – 3" squares Cut 2 – 2 ½" x WOF strips Sub-cut 10 – 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles & 12 – 2 ½" squares Cut 6 – 2 ½" x WOF strips; Set aside for Binding
Fabric C 83061-86 / 83062-47 Fabric D = 83062-58 / 83062-62 Fabric E = 83062-61 / 83063-23 Fabric G = 83062-82 / 83063-44 Fabric G = 83063-59 / 83063-82 Fabric H = 83064-58 / 83064-61	3/8 yd each	From each fabric, Cut 1 − 3" x WOF strip ➤ Sub-cut 12 − 3" squares Cut 1 − 4 ½" x WOF strip ➤ Sub-cut 10 − 4 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles
Fabric J – 81201-10 / 81205-10	2 yds	Cut 4 − 5 ½" x WOF strips Sub-cut 24 − 5 ½" squares Cut 19 − 2 ½" x WOF strips Sub-cut 80 − 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles, 20 − 2 ½" squares and 31 − 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips
Crosswise Backing – 83062-82 / 83062-62	3 ½ yds	Cut in half across the length of the fabric to get 2 – 63" x WOF pieces. Join the two pieces along the selvage edges using a ½" seam.

Flying Geese Assembly: (4-at-a-Time Method)

1. Lay out a 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square and 4 – 3" Fabric A squares. Using the 4-at-a-Time Method, make four Flying Geese Unit A's. Repeat twice to make 12 Unit A's. (You will only need 10 Units.) Trim each unit to 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " if necessary.



2. Repeat Step 1, pairing the remaining 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J squares with the 3" Fabric B – H squares to make 12 Unit B's, 12 Unit C's, etc.

Block Assembly:


- 1. Sew a 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric A rectangle to each of the Flying Geese Unit A's as shown.
- 2. Then sew a 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric J rectangle to the right-hand side to complete Unit A. Repeat for Units B H made above.



3. Referring to the finished quilt image, or to your liking, arrange four Flying Geese Units and one 2 ½" Fabric J square as shown.



4. Following the Partial Seams Diagrams below, sew units together to complete the block.



5. Repeat Steps 3 & 4 to make 20 blocks.

Quilt Top Assembly:

- 1. Referring to the finished quilt image, or to your liking, arrange blocks into five rows of four blocks each.
- 2. Sew blocks in each row together, adding a 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric J sashing strip between each block.



3. To make the horizontal sashing strips, sew $3 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J sashing strips together, adding a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square between each strip.



- 4. Sew rows together with a horizontal sashing strip between each row to complete the quilt top.
- 5. Join Fabric A binding strips together using diagonal seams. Fold in half, wrong sides together, along the length of the strip and press.
- 6. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
