Fabric Requirements & Cutting Instructions:

Fall Harvest	Petunia	Yardage	Cutting Instructions (WOF = width of fabric)	
Fabric A TCHANG42-59	Fabric A TCHANG42-85	1-10" Tile Pack	From each 10" tile, cut: $2-4\%$ " squares; $2-2\%$ " x 4% " strips; $1-2\%$ " x 5" stri (Refer to Cutting Diagram below)	
Fabric B 81300-11	Fabric B 81300-14	2 ¾ yds	Cut 33 – 2 ½" x WOF strips; Sub-cut 252 – 2 ½" squares; 42 – 2 ½" x 5" strips; 41 – 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips and 15 – 2 ½" x 18 ½" strips Cut 7 – 1 ½" x WOF strips for Inner Border	
Fabric C 83072-78	Fabric C 83072-82	2/3 yd	Cut 9 – 2 ½" x WOF strips From one strip, cut 15 – 2 ½" squares Set remaining strips aside for Binding	
Fabric D 83074-78	Fabric D 83074-48	1 ¼ yds	Cut 8 – 4 ½" x WOF strips for Outer Border	
Backing 83070-990	Backing 83070-83	5 ½ yds	Cut fabric in half along the length to get 2 – 99" x WOF pieces. Join the two pieces along the selvage edges.	

Block Instructions:

- 1. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Fabric B 2 ½" square.
- 2. For each block, you will need the pieces cut from one 10" tile (as shown in the Cutting Diagram), plus $6-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B squares and $1-2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" Fabric B strip. These will be referred to as 'Fabric A' for each block.



3. Place a 2 ½" Fabric B square in three corners of each 4 ½" Fabric A square. Pin in place. Sew along the marked lines. Trim ¼" away from the line and press the corner triangles out as shown. Make two Unit A's for each block.

4. Pair the 2 ½" x 5" Fabric A strip with a Fabric B 2 ½" x 5" strip. With right sides together, sew the strips together along the long edge. Cut strip set in half as shown.




5. Pair the units made in Step 4 with the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric A strips. With right sides together, sew pieces together to complete Unit B. Make two Unit B's for each block.

- 6. Arrange the units as shown. Sew together into rows, then sew rows together to complete the block.
- 7. Repeat Steps 2 6 for all 42 10" tiles to make 42 blocks.



Assembly Instructions:

- 8. Referring to the quilt image, arrange blocks into 7 rows of 6 blocks each.
- 9. Sew rows together, adding a 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B sashing strip between each block.



10. Join $3 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B sashing strips, adding a Fabric C 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square between each strip, as shown. Make 3.



11. Join $2 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B sashing strips and $2 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B sashing strips, adding a Fabric C 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square between each strip as shown. Make 3.



- 12. Referring to the finished quilt image, sew rows together, adding the sashing strips made in Steps 10 & 11 between each row.
- 13. Join the Fabric B inner border strips together end to end. Cut $2 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border strips and sew to each side of the quilt top. Then cut $2 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border strips and sew to the top & bottom of the quilt top.
- 14. Repeat Step 13 with the Fabric D outer border strips, cutting $2 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " side outer border strips and $2 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom border strips.
- 15. Join the Fabric C binding strips using diagonal seams. Fold length of strip in half, wrong sides together, and press.
- 16. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
