## Unicorn Illusion

Skill level: Easy
Finished Size: 73" x 80½
Cutting Instructions: wof = width of fabric

| Fabric requirements | Yards | Cutting Instructions |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Fabric A - Unicorn panel \#DP22563-44 $\left(49^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}\right)$ | 1 panel | - Trim to 42" wide and square up top and bottom edges. |
| Fabric B - Multi-color coordinate \#DP22476-44 | 11/8 yard | - Trim to 42" wide and cut into 2 equal lengths approx. 17" long. |
| Fabric C - Charcoal solid \#9000-940 | 3/4 yard | - Cut 4 strips 6"x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 801/2". |
| Fabric D - Dark grey solid \#9000-93 | 5/8 yard | - Cut 4 strips 5"x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 801/2". |
| Fabric E - grey solid \#9000-92 | 5/8 yard | - Cut 4 strips 4"x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 801/2". |
| Fabric F - Light grey solid \#9000-910 | 1/2 yard | - Cut 4 strips 3"x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 801⁄2". |
| Fabric G - Pale grey solid \#9000-900 | 1/3 yard | - Cut 4 strips 2"x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 801/2". |
| Fabric H - White solid \#9000-10 | 1/6 yard | - Cut 4 strips 2"x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 801⁄2". |
| Fabric I - Black solid \#9000-99 | 7/8 yard | - Cut 8 strips $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof; join end-to-end, press in half and reserve for binding. <br> - Cut 1 strip 6" x wof; cut into (4) 6" squares, (4) 4" squares \& (4) 2" squares. <br> - Cut 1 strip 5" x wof; cut into (4) 5" squares, (4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares \& (4) $1^{\prime \prime}$ squares. |
| Backing | 5 yards | - Cut into 2 equal lengths and join selvage-to-selvage. |

General Piecing: All seams are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless noted. Press seams toward darker fabric unless noted.

## Piecing:

1. Lay a 6 " Fabric I square on each end of the $801 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $C$ units; sew diagonally as shown, trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from sewing line and press.

2. Repeat with the $5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I squares and the Fabric D units, the 4 " Fabric I squares and the Fabric E units, the $3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I squares and the Fabric F units, the 2" Fabric I squares and the Fabric G units, and the 1" Fabric I squares and the Fabric H units.
3. Sew a Fabric B piece to top and bottom edges of the Fabric A panel and trim to $801 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
4. Starting at left edge, cut the panel lengthwise into the following strips in the order indicated:

5. Using the photo and diagram as a guide, arrange the panel strips alternately with the Fabric C-H strips, starting and ending with the Fabric C strips. Sew together, sewing with the panel strips on top. Press seams toward Fabrics C-H.



Finishing:
Layer the prepared backing, a $77^{\prime \prime} \times 86^{\prime \prime}$ piece of batting and the quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired. Trim edges even with quilt top. Sew the prepared binding to the edges with a $1 / 4$ " seam, turn and stitch in place. Enjoy your new quilt!
