Unicorn Illusion

Skill level: Easy

Finished Size: 73" x 801/2

Cutting Instructions: wof = width of fabric

Fabric requirements	Yards	Cutting Instructions
Fabric A - Unicorn panel #DP22563-44 (49" x 42")	1 panel	Trim to 42" wide and square up top and bottom edges.
Fabric B - Multi-color coordinate #DP22476-44	1½ yard	Trim to 42" wide and cut into 2 equal lengths approx. 17" long.
Fabric C - Charcoal solid #9000-940	¾ yard	• Cut 4 strips 6" x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 801/2".
Fabric D - Dark grey solid #9000-93	5⁄8 yard	• Cut 4 strips 5" x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 80½".
Fabric E - grey solid #9000-92	⅓ yard	• Cut 4 strips 4" x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 80½".
Fabric F - Light grey solid #9000-910	½ yard	• Cut 4 strips 3" x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 80½".
Fabric G - Pale grey solid #9000-900	⅓ yard	• Cut 4 strips 2" x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 801/2".
Fabric H - White solid #9000-10	% yard	• Cut 4 strips 2" x wof; join end-to-end in pairs and trim to 801/2".
Fabric I - Black solid #9000-99	% yard	 Cut 8 strips 2" x wof; join end-to-end, press in half and reserve for binding. Cut 1 strip 6" x wof; cut into (4) 6" squares, (4) 4" squares & (4) 2" squares. Cut 1 strip 5" x wof; cut into (4) 5" squares, (4) 3" squares & (4) 1" squares.
Backing	5 yards	Cut into 2 equal lengths and join selvage-to-selvage.

General Piecing: All seams are 1/4" unless noted. Press seams toward darker fabric unless noted.

Piecing:

1. Lay a 6" Fabric I square on each end of the $80\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C units; sew diagonally as shown, trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from sewing line and press.




- **2.** Repeat with the 5" Fabric I squares and the Fabric D units, the 4" Fabric I squares and the Fabric E units, the 3" Fabric I squares and the Fabric F units, the 2" Fabric I squares and the Fabric G units, and the 1" Fabric I squares and the Fabric H units.
- **3.** Sew a Fabric B piece to top and bottom edges of the Fabric A panel and trim to $80\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- **4.** Starting at left edge, cut the panel lengthwise into the following strips in the order indicated:

 $1\frac{1}{2}" \quad 2\frac{1}{2}" \quad 3\frac{1}{2}" \quad 4\frac{1}{2}" \quad 5\frac{1}{2}" \quad 7" \quad 5\frac{1}{2}" \quad 4\frac{1}{2}" \quad 3\frac{1}{2}" \quad 2\frac{1}{2}" \quad 1\frac{1}{2}"$

5. Using the photo and diagram as a guide, arrange the panel strips alternately with the Fabric C-H strips, starting and ending with the Fabric C strips. Sew together, sewing with the panel strips on top. Press seams toward Fabrics C-H.





Finishing:

Layer the prepared backing, a 77" x 86" piece of batting and the quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired. Trim edges even with quilt top. Sew the prepared binding to the edges with a ¼" seam, turn and stitch in place. Enjoy your new quilt!
