83012-49 Fabric A	***	3/8 yd	Cut 2 – 4 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 – 4 ½" squares
81300-34 Fabric B		3/8 yd	Cut 4 − 2 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 − 2 ½" x 4 ½ strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 − 2 ½" x 6 ½ strips
83013-23 Fabric C		1 1/2 yds	Cut 11 − 2 ½" x WOF strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 − 2 ½" x 6 ½ strips ➤ Sub-cut 12 − 2 ½" x 8 ½ strips ➤ Sub-cut 24 − 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips Cut 8 − 2 ½" x WOF strips (Binding)
81000-125 Fabric D		1 yd	Cut 6 – 2 ½" x WOF strips Sub-cut 12 – 2 ½" x 8 ½ strips Sub-cut 12 – 2 ½" x 10 ½ strips Cut 7 – 2 ½" x WOF strips (Middle Border)
83012-1018 Fabric E		1 5/8 yds	Cut 2 − 11" x WOF strips > Sub-cut 6 − 11" squares Cut 7 − 4 ½" x WOF strips (Outer Border)
83010-12 Fabric F		2/3 yd	Cut 2 − 11" x WOF strips > Sub-cut 6 − 11" squares
83013-49 Fabric G		1/2 yd	Cut 6 − 2 ½" x WOF strips (Inner Border) ➤ Sub-cut 6 − 2 ½" squares from one strip (for Center Squares)
83012-49 Backing	***	5 1/2 yds	Cut the fabric in half along the length to get 2 – 2 ¾ yd pieces. Sew pieces together along the selvage edges to get a lengthwise backing measuring approximately 84" x 99".

All seams are sewn using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

The quilt center is made up of 6 – 22" blocks as shown, each with two half log cabin units, two HST units, plus sashing and center square in between the units, making construction of the quilt fast & easy!

Half Log Cabin Unit Assembly:

- 1. Starting with a Fabric A square, add strips to two sides of the square in the order of Fabric B 4 ½" & 6 ½" strips, Fabric C 6 ½" & 8 ½" strips & Fabric D 8 ½" & 10 ½" strips, alternating between the two sides as shown.
- 2. Repeat to make a total of 12 Half Log Cabin Units.





HST Unit Assembly:

- 1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the 6 11" Fabric F squares.
- 2. Pair a Fabric E 11" square with a Fabric F 11" square.
- 3. With right sides together, sew a ¼" seam on each side of the drawn line.
- 4. Cut on the drawn line. Open and press to the dark side. Trim each unit to 10 %" x 10 %".
- 5. Repeat with remaining 11" squares to make a total of 12 HST Units.

Block Assembly:

1. Lay out two Half Log Cabin Units, two HST Units, 4 sashing strips and one center square as shown.



- 2. Sew units together into rows. Then sew rows together to complete block.
- 3. Repeat to make a total of 6 blocks.

Quilt Top Assembly:

- 1. Sew blocks together into three rows of two blocks each. Then sew rows together to complete quilt center.
- 2. Join the Fabric G Inner Border strips end-to-end. From that long strip, cut $2-66 \frac{1}{2}$ " side border strips and $2-48 \frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom border strips.
- 3. Sew a side border strip to each side of the quilt top. Then add the top & bottom border strips.
- 4. Join the Fabric D Middle Border strips end-to-end. From that long strip, cut 2-70 %" side border strips and 2-56 %" top & bottom border strips.
- 5. Sew a side border strip to each side of the quilt top. Then add the top & bottom border strips.
- 6. Join the Fabric E Outer Border strips end-to-end. From that long strip, cut $2-78 \frac{1}{2}$ " side border strips and $2-60 \frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom border strips.
- 7. Sew a side border strip to each side of the quilt top. Then add the top & bottom border strips.

Finishing the Quilt:

- 1. Layer quilt top with batting and prepared backing. Quilt as desired.
- 2. Join the Fabric C Binding strips using diagonal seams. Fold in half wrong sides together along the length of the strip and press.
- 3. Bind quilt using your favorite method.
