

## Where Poppies Grow

Collection – **Stonehenge Oh Canada! 11** Finished Size - 56" x 68" WOF = Width of Fabric All seams are sewn using a ¼" seam allowance

Requirement		Yardage	Cutting Instructions
	Fabric A 25236-99	1 1/3 yds	Cut 12 – 3 ½" x WOF strips; Sub-cut 128 – 3 ½" squares
10 m 10	Fabric B 25237-99	3/4 yd	Cut 3 – 6 ½" x WOF strips; Sub-cut 15 – 6 ½" squares
	Fabric C 25238-24	1 3/8 yds	Cut 6 – 6 ½" x WOF strips (Outer Border)
	Fabric D 24267-12	1 1/4 yds	Cut 3 – 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; Sub-cut 16 – 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares Cut 6 – 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips; Sub-cut 128 – 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares Cut 5 – 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; Sub-cut 128 – 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
	Fabric E 24272-23	1/2 yd	Cut 7 – 2 ¼″ x WOF strips (Binding)
	Fabric F 3954-96	1/2 yd	Cut 4 – 1 ¼" x WOF strips; Sub-cut 128 – 1 ¼" squares Cut 5 – 1 ½" x WOF strips (Inner Border)
	Crosswise Backing 25237-12	4 yds	Cut backing fabric in half along length of fabric. Join the two pieces along the selvage edges.

## **Block Assembly:**

- 1. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1 ¾" & 1 ½" Fabric D squares, and the 1 ¼" Fabric F squares.
- 2. Layer a 1 ½" Fabric D square in the top left corner of a 3 ½" Fabric A square, right sides together, and sew along the marked line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line and press the marked piece open.
- 3. Repeat Step 2 with a 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Fabric D square in the top right corner, and a 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Fabric F square in the lower right corner to complete Unit 1 as shown.
- 4. Repeat Steps 2 & 3 to make four Unit 1's.
- 5. Arrange units in two rows of two blocks, rotating the blocks as shown. Sew blocks in each row together, then sew rows together to complete the Poppy Block.



6. Repeat Steps 2-5 to make 32 Poppy Blocks.

## **Quilt Top Assembly:**

7. Arrange Poppy Blocks, alternating with Fabric B & D 6" squares, as shown below.



- 8. Sew blocks together to form rows. Then sew rows together to complete quilt top.
- Join the Fabric F Inner Border strips end to end. Cut 2 − 54 ½" strips and sew to sides of quilt top. Then cut 2 − 44 ½" strips and sew to the top & bottom of the quilt top.
- 10. Join the Fabric C Outer Border strips end to end. Cut  $2 56 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sew to sides of quilt top. Then cut  $2 68 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sew to the top & bottom to complete the quilt top.
- 11. Join Fabric E binding strips using diagonal seams. Fold this long strip in half wrong sides together and press.
- 12. Layer quilt top with prepared backing and batting. Quilt as desired. Trim edges and bind using your favorite method.
