Fabric Requirements \& Cutting Instructions:

| Fabric | Yardage | Cutting Instructions (WOF = width of fabric) |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Group 1 $81700-69,-62,-48,-86$ | $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$ each | Cut 3-2 $1 / 2 / 2 \times$ WOF strips from each fabric in Group 1 |
| Group 2 $81700-72,-75,-61,-42$ | $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$ each | Cut $3-2 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times$ WOF strips from each fabric in Group 2 |
| Group 3 81700-58,-25,-23,-85 | $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$ each | Cut 3-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from each fabric in Group 3 |
| Group 4 81700-53,-24,-28,-88 | $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$ each | Cut $3-2 \frac{1}{2} / 1 \times$ WOF strips from each fabric in Group 4 |
| 81000-800 <br> Sashing | $3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ | $\begin{aligned} & \text { Cut } 16-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times \text { WOF strips } \\ & \quad>\text { Sub-cut } 31-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime} \text { strips } \end{aligned}$ |
| 81700-88 <br> Cornerstones \& Binding | $5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$ |  |
| 81700-88 <br> Lengthwise Backing | 5 yds | Cut the fabric in half along the length to get two 90" pieces. Sew pieces together along the selvage edges to get a backing measuring approximately $84^{\prime \prime} \times 90^{\prime \prime}$ |

## Block Instructions:

1. Sew $1-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip of each color in Group 1 together in the order listed above to make Strip Set 1. Repeat with the remaining two strips of each color in Group 1.
2. Using the $45^{\circ}$ line on your ruler, cut $8-45^{\circ}$ triangles from each Strip Set. Turn ruler on every other cut to get opposite triangles, and include a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance at one end of each triangle as shown. Repeat cutting to yield $24-45^{\circ}$ Triangle Units from the three Strip Sets (12 in each orientation).
3. Repeat Steps $1 \& 2$ using the colors in Group 2.

4. Arrange Triangle Units into blocks as shown. Sew each quadrant together (the $1 / 4$ " seams should cross each other $1 / 4$ " in from the raw edge). Trim each Block Unit to $10^{\prime \prime}$, lining up the horizontal seam with the $45^{\circ}$ line on the ruler and centering the ruler on the block. Sew Block Units together into rows, then sew rows together. Make three blocks in each
 orientation. Block should measure $161 / 2 \prime$ square (unfinished).
5. Repeat Steps $1-4$ using the colors in Group $2 \& 3$.
6. Referring to the finished quilt image, arrange blocks in four rows of three blocks each. Sew blocks together into rows with a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip between each block and at each end of the row as shown.

7. To make the horizontal sashing strips, sew $3-1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 16 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips together with a $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cornerstone between each strip and at each end as shown. Make 5 horizontal sashing strips.
8. Sew rows together with a horizontal sashing strip between each row and at the top \& bottom to complete the quilt top.
9. To prepare binding, sew the $7-2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF binding strips together using diagonal seams. Fold in half, wrong sides together along the length of the strip, and press.
10. Layer quilt top with batting \& backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method.
