






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# Wild Night

Finished Size: 42" x 61"

All seams are sewn using a ¼" seam allowance

Fabric Requirements		Yardage	Cutting Instructions (WOF = width of fabric)
<b>Fabric A</b> – Center Panel 40054-57		2/3 yard	Trim to 22 ½" x 41 ½"
<b>Fabric B</b> – Inner Border 40009-46*		1/3 yard	Cut 4 – 2 ½" x WOF strips
<b>Fabric C</b> – Middle Border 40056-57		7/8 yard	Cut 4 – 6 ½" x WOF strips
<b>Fabric D</b> – Outer Border 40009-89*		1/2 yd	Cut 5 – 2 ½" x WOF strips
<b>Fabric E</b> – Cornerstones 40009-12* (Small)		1/8 yd	Cut 1 – 2 ½" x WOF strip ➤ Sub-cut 8 – 2 ½" squares
<b>Fabric F</b> – Cornerstones 40064-89 (Large)		1/4 yd	Cut 1 – 6 ½" x WOF strip ➤ Sub-cut 4 – 6 ½" squares
<b>Fabric G</b> – Binding 40057-53		1/2 yard	Cut 6 – 2 ¼" x WOF strips; set aside for binding
<b>Backing</b> 40056-57		3 yds	Cut in half along length of fabric to get 2 – 54" pieces. Sew together along selvage edges for a backing piece measuring approximately 53" x 82"

## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

1. Trim two Fabric B inner border strips to 41 ½" and sew one to each side of trimmed center panel. Press seams toward the center. Trim two Fabric B inner border strips to 22 ½". Sew a 2 ½" x 2 ½" cornerstone to each end of both strips. Press seams toward the cornerstones. Then sew these strips to the top & bottom of the center panel, pressing the seams toward the center.
2. Join Fabric C middle border strips on the short edges. From this long strip, cut 2 – 46 ½" middle border strips and sew to each side of the quilt top. Then cut 2 – 26 ½" middle border strips. Sew a 6 ½" x 6 ½" cornerstone to each end of both strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
3. Join Fabric D outer border strips on the short edges. From this long strip, cut 2 – 57 ½" outer border strips and sew to each side of the quilt top. Then cut 2 – 42 ½" outer border strips. Sew a 2 ½" x 2 ½" cornerstone to each end of both strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
4. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
5. Join the binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Fold in half along length of strip, wrong sides together. Bind using your favorite method.
