## FREE PATTERN

- Make the same block twice
- Blocks are mirror images
- Unfinished block size is 9 1/2"


Block 12a.


Block 12b.

2 contrasting fabrics-1/8 yard each
Label your fabrics \#1 and \#2 (It doesn't matter which way you label them)
From each of the fabrics cut:
Cut (4) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut (1) 3 ½" square
Cut remaining fabric into (2) 2 " strips (see cutting diagram below)


Block 12a. Take one of the 2" strips from fabric \# 1 and one of the 2" strips from fabric \#2. Sew strips together and sub cut into $31 / 2 "$ sections yielding four squares. (See below).


Take (1) $37 / 8$ " square from fabric \#1 and (1) $37 / 8$ " square from fabric \#2. Place one square of each fabric right sides together and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one of the squares. Pin. Stitch a scant $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and you have two sewn half square triangle units! Repeat this process to yield a total of four sewn half square triangle units. See diagram below.


Place units as shown in Block 12a. diagram above with (1) 3 1/2" square from fabric \#1 in the center. Sew units together.

Block 12b. Take one of the 2" strips from fabric \#2 and one of the 2" strips from fabric \#1. Sew strips together and sub cut into $31 / 2$ " sections yielding four squares. (See diagram above).

Take (1) $37 / 8$ " square from fabric \#2 and (1) $37 / 8$ " square from fabric \#1. Place one square of each fabric right sides together and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one of the squares. Pin. Stitch a scant $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and you have two sewn half square triangle units! Repeat this process to yield a total of four sewn half square triangle units. See diagram above.
Place units as shown in Block 12b. diagram above with (1) $31 / 2$ " square from fabric \#2 in the center. Sew units together
