Blocks shown in Swept Away Collection DP23366-94 & DP23367-92







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- Make the same block twice
- Blocks are mirror images
- Unfinished block size is 9 1/2"


Block 14b.

2 contrasting fabrics - 1/6 yard (or 6") each Label your fabrics #1 and #2 (It doesn't matter which way you label them) From each of the fabrics cut:

(1) 3 ½" x WOF strip & (1) 2" x WOF strip Cut (9) 3 ½" squares & (18) 2" squares

Block 14a. Take (9) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ squares from fabric #1 and (18) 2" squares from fabric #2. Place one of the 2" squares right sides together onto the bottom right corner of the 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown. Sew along drawn line. Cut off excess fabric $\frac{1}{4}$ " above seam line. Press the stitched block open. Repeat this process with another 2" square on the opposite corner so that you have a pieced unit as shown in diagram below. Make (9).

Place sewn units together as shown in Block 14a. diagram above. Sew together.

Block 14b. Take (9) 3 ½ squares from fabric #2 and (18) 2" squares from fabric #1. Place one of the 2" squares right sides together onto the bottom right corner of the 3½" square. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown. Sew along drawn line. Cut off excess fabric ¼" above seam line. Press the stitched block open. Repeat this process with another 2" square on the opposite corner so that you have a pieced unit as shown in diagram above. Make (9).

Place sewn units together as shown in Block 14b. diagram above. Sew together.
