





- Make the same block twice
- Blocks are mirror images
- Unfinished block size is 9 1/2"




Block 17a.

Block 17b.

2 contrasting fabrics - 1/8 yard each Label your fabrics #1 & #2 (It doesn't matter which way you label them) From each of the fabrics cut: (1) 3 7/8" x WOF strip Cut (9) 3 7/8" squares

Take (1) 3 7/8" square from fabric #1 and (1) 3 7/8" square from fabric #2. Place one square of each fabric right sides together and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one of the squares. Pin. Stitch a scant 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and you have two sewn half square triangle units! Repeat this process to yield a total of eighteen sewn half square triangle units. See diagram below.



Block 17a. Using nine of these half square triangles, lay out your squares as shown in Block 17a. diagram above. Sew together.

Block 17b. Using the remaining nine half square triangles, lay out your squares as shown in Block 17b. diagram above. Sew together.
