2 contrasting fabrics-1/8 yard each
Label your fabrics \#1 \& \#2 (It doesn't matter which way you label them)
From each of the fabrics cut:
(4) $37 / 8$ " squares
(5) $31 / 2$ " squares
(8) 2 " squares

Block 23a. Take (1) $3^{1 / 2 \prime 2}$ " square from fabric \#1. Take (2) 2" squares from fabric \#2. Place one of the 2 " squares right sides together onto the top left corner of the $31 / 2$ " square. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown. Sew along drawn line. Cut off excess fabric $1 / 4$ " above seam line. Press the stitched block open. See diagram \#1. Repeat this process with the other 2" square on the top right corner so that you have a pieced block as shown in diagram \#2. Repeat to make four of these units.

Take (2) $37 / 8$ " squares from fabric \#1 and (2) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares from fabric \#2. Place one square of each fabric right sides together and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one of the squares. Pin. Stitch a scant $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and you have two sewn half square triangle units. Repeat this process to yield a total of four sewn half square triangle units. See diagram below.


Arrange all units as shown in Block 23a. diagram above and sew together.

Block 23b. Take (1) $31 / 2 "$ square from fabric \#2. Take (2) $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from fabric \#1. Place one of the 2 " squares right sides together onto the top left corner of the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown. Sew along drawn line. Cut off excess fabric $1 / 4$ " above seam line. Press the stitched block open. See diagram \#1. Repeat this process with the other 2" square on the top right corner so that you have a pieced block as shown in diagram \#2. Repeat to make four of these units.

Take (2) $37 / 8$ " squares from fabric \#2 and (2) $37 / 8$ " squares from fabric \#1. Place one square of each fabric right sides together and draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one of the squares. Pin. Stitch a scant $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and you have two sewn half square triangle units. Repeat this process to yield a total of four sewn half square triangle units. See diagram above.

Arrange all units as shown in Block 23b. diagram above and sew together.
